John 16:9 (NLT) ⁹ The world's sin is that it refuses to believe in me.

NLT John 16:8 And when he [Holy Spirit] comes, he will convince the world ... of God's righteousness...

NIV Luke 9:54 When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?"

NLT Luke 4:22 All who were there spoke well of him and were amazed by the gracious words that fell from his lips.

NLT John 3:17 God did not send his Son into the world to condemn it, but to save it.

NLT 2 Corinthians 2:14 But thanks be to God, who made us his captives and leads us along in Christ's triumphal procession. Now wherever we go he uses us to tell others about the Lord and to spread the Good News like a sweet perfume.

NLT 2 Corinthians 2:15-16 Our lives are a fragrance presented by Christ to God. But this fragrance is perceived differently by those being saved and by those perishing. 16 To those who are perishing we are a fearful smell of death and doom. But to those who are being saved we are a life-giving perfume. And who is adequate for such a task as this?
