NLT Romans 6:23a For the wages of sin is death...

NLT Romans 8:3 The law of Moses could not save us, because of our sinful nature. But God put into effect a different plan to save us. He sent his own Son in a human body like ours, except that ours are sinful. God destroyed sin's control over us by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins.

NLT Isaiah 64:6a We are all infected and impure with sin. When we proudly display our righteous deeds, we find they are but filthy rags.

2 Sam 12:1-14 (NLT)

¹ So the LORD sent Nathan the prophet to tell David this story: "There were two men in a certain town. One was rich, and one was poor. ² The rich man owned a great many sheep and cattle.³ The poor man owned nothing but one little lamb he had bought. He raised that little lamb, and it grew up with his children. It ate from the man's own plate and drank from his cup. He cuddled it in his arms like a baby daughter.⁴ One day a guest arrived at the home of the rich man. But instead of killing an animal from his own flock or herd, he took the poor man's lamb and killed it and prepared it for his guest."

⁵ David was furious. "As surely as the Lord lives," he vowed, "any man who would do such a thing deserves to die!⁶ He must repay four lambs to the poor man for the one he stole and for having no pity."

⁷ Then Nathan said to David, "You are that man! The LORD, the God of Israel, says: I anointed you king of Israel and saved you from the power of Saul.⁸ I gave you your master's house and his wives and the kingdoms of Israel and Judah. And if that had not been enough, I would have given you much, much more. ⁹ Why, then, have you despised the word of the LORD and done this horrible deed? For you have murdered Uriah the Hittite with the sword of the Ammonites and stolen his wife.

¹⁰ From this time on, your family will live by the sword because you have despised me by taking Uriah's wife to be your own.¹¹ "This is what the LORD says: Because of what you have done, I will cause your own household to rebel against you. I will give your wives to another man before your very eyes, and he will go to bed with them in public view.¹² You did it secretly, but I will make this happen to you openly in the sight of all Israel."

¹³ Then David confessed to Nathan, "I have sinned against the LORD." Nathan replied, "Yes, but the LORD has forgiven you, and you won't die for this sin.¹⁴ Nevertheless, because you have shown utter contempt for the LORD by doing this, your child will die."

NLT Romans 3:23 For all have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious standard.

Psalms 51:1-17 (NLT)

Have mercy on me, O God, because of your unfailing love. Because of your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins.² Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin.³ For I recognize my rebellion; it haunts me day and night.⁴ Against you, and you alone, have I sinned; I have done what is evil in your sight. You will be proved right in what you say, and your judgment against me is just.⁵ For I was born a sinner— yes, from the moment my mother conceived me.⁶ But you desire honesty from the womb, teaching me wisdom even there.⁷ Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.⁸ Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me— now let me rejoice.⁹ Don't keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt.

¹⁰ Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.¹¹ Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me.¹² Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and make me willing to obey you.¹³ Then I will teach your ways to rebels, and they will return to you.¹⁴ Forgive me for shedding blood, O God who saves; then I will joyfully sing of your forgiveness.¹⁵ Unseal my lips, O Lord, that my mouth may praise you.¹⁶ You do not desire a sacrifice, or I would offer one. You do not want a burnt offering.¹⁷ The sacrifice you desire is a broken spirit. You will not reject a broken and repentant heart, O God.
