All classes take place in the Glass Endeavors' studio at 2716 E. 31st St., Minneapolis.

Tiffany Lampshades - \$85 March 1st, Tuesdays, over 6 weeks (we take a 3 week break after the first class), 6 - 8:00pm

Build a beautiful Tiffany lamp shade using the Odyssey form system. In the first class we will discuss how to choose and use art glass in your lamp. We will skip 3 weeks after the first class. This allows time for you to cut your glass between the 1st and 2nd class. Class resumes March 29th. Come in prior to the first class to select your lamp design. (Beginning Stained Glass and Panel Lamp Class required)

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 March 2nd, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8:30pm

In this class you will make a small panel using one of many patterns the studio provides. You will learn to cut glass using a number of techniques, learn how to use special tools designed for stained glass artists and construct your panel using the copper foil technique. Our high quality tool kit includes an 80w soldering iron, running and grozing pliers, 1 pound of 50/50 solder, a carbide steel wheel glass cutter, flux, flux brush and a black pen. It is discounted from \$158 to \$125 for our students. Other materials for the beginner panel run \$80 on average over the 4 week class. No experience needed.

Heads & Tails Glass Art - \$65 March 5th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30 - 12:30pm

We've been jealously guarding our new horde of heads and tails glass, but it's finally time to share. Head glass is unique in that it has a rolled edge to it that looks especially interesting when left raw, particularly when assembled in a table top stand. The first day students will pick out a few choice pieces of these special cut-offs and in class we'll work toward crafting those pieces into sculptural and dimensional art. Beginning stained glass required.

Painting with Glassline Paints - \$55 March 8th, Tuesdays, 3 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Glassline is a high fire glass paint you may use to embellish fused pieces or illustrate traditional stained glass work. We will guide you through the best methods for getting the finished products you want using this versatile paint. Come with line images of designs or pictures of images you'd like to render. Bring cutting and breaking tools. Cutting experience needed.

Edge Up- \$75 March 30th, Wednesday, 1 night, 4 - 8pm

Whether you've taken it before, have some fusing experience or have no idea how to do anything in glass, this is the class for you. Each student will assemble one or two bowls using glass strips and bits of rods over the course of this 4 hour long class. If you've never cut glass before we'll show you how. If you want a class where you and your kids work together on something amazing, now is your chance! All you need to bring is a bit of patience and maybe some tweezers. Sign up soon because this class will fill up. No experience needed.

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 April 2nd, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30 - 1pm

Crash Glass Mosaics - \$65 April 6th, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8pm

With winter on it's way out, its time to start thinking mosaics again. This is a direct mosaic class with a recycling twist. Students will combine high-end art glass with scavenged pieces of broken tempered glass to create a final window panel that is simple, yet stunning. This class is perfect for the inexperienced artist looking to understand glass mosaics as well as the advanced artist looking to rediscover the beauty in art glass. No experience needed.
