All classes take place in the Glass Endeavors studio at 2716 E. 31st St., Minneapolis.

Garden Orbs - \$75 July 5th, Tuesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8pm

This exciting new class offers you the opportunity to learn how to create your own cast cement garden art planters and structures. We'll begin with a form and teach you the steps to make it a cement shape on which to mosaic. We'll take you through the mosaic process and finish with grouting and sealing. Come in before the class to get a materials list.

Saucer Melts - \$60 July 6th, Wednesdays, 3 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Spectacular patterns and endless color variations are what you get when fusing with this amazing technique. You will be guided through fusing your own crazy patterned glass, cold working and slumping in this fantastic class. Come in before the class to get a materials list.

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 July 9th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 1:00pm

In this class you will make a small panel using one of many patterns the studio provides. You will learn to cut glass using a number of techniques, learn how to use special tools designed for stained glass artists and construct your panel using the copper foil technique. Our high quality tool kit includes an 80w soldering iron, running and grozing pliers, 1 pound of 50/50 solder, solder flux, flux brush, a carbide steel wheel glass cutter and a pattern pen.

Lacey Candle Light - \$25 July 27th, Wednesdays, 1 evening, 6 - 8pm

Get your fusing feet wet with this quick little votive lesson. No cutting experience necessary and projects will be ready for pick up one week from class.

We will close Thursday, June 30th at 4pm and be closed through Monday, July 4th.

Variety with Vitrograph - \$50 August 2nd, Tuesdays, 2 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Pull your own stringer, cane and wig-wags, learn about manipulating reactive glasses and

incorporate lots of this long, curly glass into a spectacular plate or tile. We keep a large tub of vitrograph on hand to use in our fused art. It adds an abstract, organic and colorful interest to any fused or mosaic art.

Beginning Stained Glass - \$85 August 3rd, Wednesdays, 4 weeks, 6 - 8:30pm

Leaded Windows - \$75 August 6th, Saturdays, 4 weeks, 10:30am - 12:30pm

Learn how to construct windows using lead came and zinc. We'll discuss reinforcement using re-bar and appropriate designs for leaded windows. You will need a soldering iron, lead cutter, glass cutter, pliers and pattern and glass supplies for your window. Window designs should be no larger than 18" x 24" and 30 pieces or fewer. Come by before class to have your pattern approved. Beginning Stained Glass is required.

Fusing Organics - \$65 August 16th, Tuesdays, 3 weeks, 6 - 8pm

Many techniques are employed when making our Fused Organics. We'll work with powder and mix our own colors for shading and variations in the glass medallion focal pieces. We'll show you how to cold work this delicate, lacey glass and set them up in the kiln for firing into exquisite wall art. Numerous firing schedules will be fully discussed so you can duplicate your success at home.
