

Rules of the Trail and Riding Safety

All guest must be in good physical condition; able to safely mount and dismount.

Weight restrictions are enforced. Weight limit of 235lbs per rider.

All rides will last a minimum of 1.5 hours so please be prepared with sunscreen and bug spray.

Each person rides their own horse, no double riding

No alcohol, drugs, ecigarettes, or normal cigarettes allowed. Firearms are prohibited.

The minimum age limit is 10 years old, all riders aged 17 years and younger must be accompanied by an adult.

Closed toed shoes are required and pants preferred! No sandals, flip flops, or open toed shoes of any kind are allowed.

We ask that you provide a minimum of 24hr notice for cancellations so we can book other folks in this time slot.

Please arrive on time for Safety Briefing and Horse Assignment. If you are late we ask that you move to the next available ride time, or reschedule for another ride day.

Please make sure that all cell phones, car keys, wallets, and articles of clothing are securely attached. We are not responsible for any misplaced or lost items. All cell phones must be on silent mode and no vibration.

Dogs and other pets will not be allowed near horses

For safety reasons no backpacks or purses are allowed on rides.

Please stay on the trail behind the trail boss and single file with a length of 1-2 horses.

Please don't let your horse crowd into other horses

Sit in center of the saddle, balanced, with your weight evenly distributed.

When horses are climbing keep your weight forward over the withers to take pressure off kidneys.

All rides are subject to availability, weather, and trail conditions. We reserve the right to alter, modify, or cancel a ride due to bad weather, unsafe conditions, or request made by owner. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone for any reason.

Payment in full is due before ride.

No Feeding of horses at anytime without prior permission.

Trail rides are walk only unless you are booked for experienced trail ride. Then will be walk and trot!

All riders must be able to follow simple instructions/directions given by trail guides to control horse.

Riders who display fearful or unsafe behavior will be asked to not ride at trail guide discretion.

No rowdy or unruly behavior on horseback or around horses is permissible at any time.
