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AFTER CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Proper care following your procedure is required to achieve optimum results. If the aftercare instructions are not followed correctly, an unpredictable amount of color may be lost. Please follow the directions below as specified by your technician.
- The area may be swollen and tender for up to 72 Hours. Place ice in a bag over a lightly moistened paper towel over the procedural area. Be sure to ice the area down until swelling is minimal.
- Darkness, thickness and unevenness of shape is normal due to swelling.
- Do not touch the procedural site during the healing process to avoid bacterial infection. Avoid direct shower spray. If water gets on area, blot dry with clean towel. Avoid makeup application directly onto area, do not expose treated area to hot tubs, sauna, swimming, excessive sun, facial cleansers, toners or lotions, and no heavy exercising for 3-5 days.
- Dryness around the area will start within 3-5 days. When flaking/scabbing begins, you may rinse the area very gently with cool water or apply a thin film of ointment (provided), 1-2 times a day with a cotton swab or clean finger for 5-7 days or until flaking/scabbing is done (less ointment is needed for oily skin). **Please follow your instructions directed from your technician**
- Tenderness, dryness, and itching are normal during the healing process. If a scab appears, do not pick, peel, or scratch. The color may heal unevenly. Scarring and infection could also be at risk.
- When flaking/scabbing is done, the color will appear very light, may also appear slightly pinkish due to healing of tissue. This is normal. Allow the inside-dermal layer of skin to heal and the color will slightly darken after 4 weeks.
- An unpredictable amount of color will be lost (approximately between 20%-60%+). In some cases due to scaring (from previous tattooing), large pores, oily skin, certain skin types, or medications, color may not appear at all. It is unforeseen how much color your body will retain. You may need a second, third or fourth application to meet your expectations of color preference.

<p><u>EYEBROW</u> Monitor the area for any oozing of lymph, blood, and plasma secretion. Press area firmly but gently to remove. If body fluids remain on the area(s), a thick scab will develop and inhibit color pigment saturation. Blotting may be discontinued when the secretion stops. Oozing may occur 2-3 days.</p>	<p><u>EYELINER</u> Swelling may peak the next morning. Keep salt intake to a minimum. If mucus has formed, the lashes may be stuck together. Gently rinse the area with water. Please be careful not to get ointment in eyes. If lotion gets in eyes, rinse with cool water.</p>	<p><u>LIP:</u> Be sure to keep your lips moisturized at all times. DO NOT EAT any type of citrus fruits, oily, hot, spicy, and sea foods. No kissing or stretching of the mouth. Drink from a straw if possible for 5-7 days or until healed.</p>
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FOR LIP PROCEDURE: Due to unknown Herpes Simplex 1 Virus (cold sores on the outer edge of mouth), a breakout of lesions may occur around area of application. I understand that a breakout may occur and I accept the risk and complications that may be involved. _____initial

Please call us if any of the following symptoms occur:

- Excessive swelling that moves outside of the procedural area.
- Inflammation, itchiness, irritation of the tissue around the procedural area after 72 Hours.
- Oozing of yellowish secretion or sharp pain in the procedural area.

Due to exposure of environmental bacteria during the healing period, there is always a low risk of infection to the procedural site. I understand that pigment colors may fade and may not match perfectly or appear exactly as expected. There is no guarantee of how much color will stay in the skin. My body may reject the pigment. I understand that **Alluring LLC** has a no refund policy regardless of individual outcome or expectations. It is our policy to provide the best work possible for all clients. We have no control over outcome due to client's skin tissue response.

Due to skin type, pigment saturation may not adhere to the skin within the first application. The follow up appointment fee will be \$75.00. To ensure dermal layer has healed properly, allow 4-8 weeks from the procedure date for the retouch to be scheduled. For appropriate saturation, you must comply with the follow up process. Should you require another application, a fee of \$75.00 will be charged. (This fee will be honored for up to 4-8 weeks from your last application). All fees plus 4.712% for Hawaii State tax will be charged. Other Fees: _____

Future Retouch fee is \$150.00 (\$200-\$250 for hair stroke, feathering, designer liner, lip liner, lip fade, full lip). When color fades it is an indication that you need a retouch (usually 1-3 years). Due to skin type, colors may fade faster than expected. Remember, oily skin, sun, chlorine/sea water, facial soaps, toner, lotions, active life style, perspiring, medications, and your body's own natural exfoliation will fade the permanent makeup. Higher fees may apply if retouch is more than 3 years from last procedure date or if the permanent make up is totally faded.
