Day 1 – Departure (Meals: L, D)

Meet at Honolulu International Airport; 9:00AM at LOBBY 8

Asiana Airlines Flight OZ 231 Departs Honolulu at 11:20AM

Check-in at designated counter. You'll only need your passport to check-in. Baggage allowance is two (2) baggages at fifty (50) pounds each. Any over limit baggage are incidental expense and you shall be responsible for the charges. You will receive your boarding pass and baggage claim ticket after checking in.

Day 2 – Welcome to KOREA! (Meals: D)

Arrival to Incheon International Airport at 5:10 PM

After retrieving your baggage(s) and clearing customs you will be welcomed by our local guide / coordinator. You'll be given some time to exchange cash at the airport and escorted to your charter bus. You will be transported to Seoul for dinner.

*Incheon to Seoul approximately 1:20 hour drive

Dinner will be provided prior to hotel check-in. The guide will assist you to check-in at the designated hotel provided with breakfast coupon and room key.

Day 3 – Seoul (Meals: B, L, D)

We begin the day by taking you to a money exchange office, offering you one of the best exchange rates available for USD to Korean Won.

MBC Dramia Center

MBC Dramia Center is an outdoor film set owned by Munhwa Broadcasting Company (MBC) and the city of Yongin. It has been re-created based on historical records and very accurately reflects the structures and culture of ancient times. This Drama set has served as the filming location for hugely popular Korean historical dramas such as "Jumong," "Queen Seon-deok," "Isan," and "Dong Yi."

Icheon Ceramics Activity

Icheon has been a valuable city for ceramic arts since originating in the Bronze Age. It was designated as a "City of Crafts and Folk Art" on the UNESCO Creative Cities Network in 2010. Here visitors can see a variety of Korea's finest ceramics such as Cheongja (celadon porcelain), Baekja (white porcelain) and Buncheongsagi (grayish-blue powdered celadon). You will also have an opportunity to make your own pottery creation.

Suwon Castle

Suwon is the capital Gyeonggi-do, South Korea's most populous province which surrounds Seoul. Suwon Hwaseong Fortress embraces the downtown area of Suwon and was built as a show of the King's filial piety towards his father during the latter part of the Joseon Dynasty. It was designated a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site in 1997.

Lotte World Tower

Lotte World Tower is a 123-floor, 555-meter skyscraper currently under construction, expected to be completed in October 2016. Its shopping and entertainment complex next to the tower building contains the largest Lotte Duty Free Shop in Korea, Lotte Department Store, the Lotte Avenue Store featuring high-end brand names, plus the 'Star Avenue,' a special area dedicated for visitors to experience the essence of the Korean Wave through interactive multimedia designed with life-size figures of Korean Wave stars.

Han River Cruise

Han River Cruise is one of the best ways to enjoy the scenery in Seoul. Cool wind from the river, the surrounding city lights and on-board live entertainment are the rewards the cruise can offer you.

Day 4 – Seoul / Jeju (Meals: B, L, D)

We begin the day checking out of the hotel and departing to Gimpo Airport for flight to Jeju Island. The flight is 1 hour and 5 min. For this flight, we're limited to 1 check-in luggage at 50 pounds. Therefore, if you're traveling with 2 pieces of luggage we'll have it stored at our hotel in Seoul. You're gone for 2 nights only and you'll get your baggage when checking in at the hotel in Seoul.

Sanbangsan Mountain

Sanbangsan Mountain is the result of violent volcanic activity some 700,000 to 800,000 years ago and is in fact a huge body of lava. As its name 'sanbang' – literally meaning 'a cave inside a mountain' – suggests, this mountain contains a cave, which is located about 150m above sea level and has a spectacular view out over the ocean. Due to its close location to the sea and its high elevation, the peak is often ringed with clouds.

PLAY KPOP JEJU

PLAY KPOP JEJU is a digital museum/theme park where visitors can travel to the past through music, enjoy K-pop stars' hologram concerts and even a date with favorite stars through virtual reality. K-pop merchandise and related products are also available at PLAY KPOP SHOP inside.

Jungmun-Daepo Jusangjeolli Cliff

At the base of this cliff is the Jisatgae Coast along with the imposing stone pillars. The Jusangjeolli are stone pillars piled up along the coast and is a designated cultural monument of Jeju Island. The Jusangjeolli was formed when the lava from Mt. Hallasan erupted into the sea of Jungmun. They are rock pillars shaped like cubes or hexagons of various sizes and almost seem as if stonemasons had carved them out. The waves of the high tides crashing into the side of the cliff provide a breathtaking view of the ocean surrounding the pillars.

Day 5 – Jeju (Meals: B, L, D)

Cheonjeyeon Falls

Cheonjeyeon, meaning "God's pond," derives its name from the legend that the seven fairies serving the King of Heaven came down to the pond on stairs of cloud and bathed in its clean waters. Around the falls, a variety of plant life thrives, and to the east, there is a cave where cold water pours from the ceiling to create a waterfall. In Cheonjeyeon Valley, visitors can see "Seonimgyo Bridge" (arched bridge with 7 nymphs carved on the side) and the octagonal "Cheonjeru tower."

Seogwipo Pleasure Boat

The primary city of the southern coast of the island, Seogwipo is a fishing port with beautiful views. Seogwipo Pleasure Boat offers dazzling scenery on the coastal lines and islands around the port. Famous for its scenery worldwide, it has been a definite tour course for international dignitaries and tourists visiting Jeju.

Fruit Picking

Here you'll get hands on activity to pick fresh fruits such as grapes, apples, pears or tangerines. Due to seasonal changes and availability we may have a different course or activity.

Jeju Folk Village

Located at the foot of Mt. Hala on Jeju Island, Seongeup Folk Village is a small town that holds a vast amount of culture. You can see the unique culture of Jeju Island; the black lava rock walls, the straight but curvy alleys to block the wind, and the stone grandfather status (Harubang), which have become a prime feature of the landscape.

Seongsan Ilchulbong - "Haenyeo" Diver's Bar

Seongsan Ilchulbong, also called "Sunrise Peak," is an archetypal tuff cone rose under the sea in a volcanic eruption over 100,000 years ago. Located on the eastern end of Jeju Island, there is a huge crater at the top of Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak. With the 99 sharp rocks surrounding the crater, it looks like a gigantic crown.

Haenyeo, literally meaning "sea women," are female divers in Jeju Island. Unlike fishermen who go out in boats or use a rod or line, these women dive in the ocean without any special tools to gather clams, abalone, or seaweed. Today, haenyeos play the role of guardians of the sea and the ocean's ecological environment. Their cooperatives operate seafood restaurants and shops.

Day 6 – Jeju / Seoul (Meals: B, L, D)

Hamdeok Beach

Located east of Jeju City, Hamdeok Beach is famous for its clean and shallow water, attracting many family visitors during summer vacations. The beach offers great scenery with its emerald-blue water, an arched bridge over black basalt and a red lighthouse.

Black Pork Street

The Jeju Black Pig is a breed of domestic pig with black skin (hence the name) found on Jeju Island. This particular delicacy is a Jeju speciality and there is the famous Black Pork Street lined with lots of restaurant serving BBQ Black Pork.

Gwanghwamun Square

Located at the main entrance of Gyeongbokgung Palace is The Statue of King Sejong the Great, the creator of Hangeul, the Korean alphabet and Korea's national hero, Statue of Admiral Yi Soon-Shin comes with its wide range of attractions. The Square is the walking path between Cheonggyecheon Stream and Gyeongbokgung Palace.

Day 7 – Seoul (Meals: B, L, D)

South Gate Market (Namdaemun Market) OR Myeondong Market

It's the largest traditional market in Korea with various goods in store. All products are sold at affordable prices and the stores in this area also function as a wholesale markets. Most of the goods are made by the storeowners. You may deal for better price with cash and quantity. Myeondong is one of the primary shopping districts in Seoul with many brand name shops, department stores, cosmetics shops, restaurants as well as street stalls.

Insadong Market

Insadong is one of the most memorable attractions in Seoul and represents the focal point of Korean traditional culture and crafts. Stores in Insadong specialize in a wide variety of goods that can only be purchased or appreciated in Korea: hanbok (traditional clothing), hanji (traditional paper), traditional teas, pottery, and folk crafts.

Gwangjang Market

This is the nation's first market and continues to thrive as a must see destination. There are stores that offer silk, satin and linen bed-sheets, the largest selection in Seoul. At this market you'll also find a variety of street food and snacks.

East Gate Market (Dongdaemun Market)

It is a large commercial district comprising traditional markets and shopping centers, specializing in wholesale and retail clothing. A full range of fashion items that cover head to toe, are found here at inexpensive prices.

Miso - Live Traditional Musical Show

Jeongdong Theater's "Korean Traditional Stage" performance is the most representative performance in Korean traditional arts. Here the audience can enjoy a selection of traditional instruments performed with dances and folk legend story telling.

Day 8 – Seoul / Incheon (Meals: B, L, D, B)

It's the last day of the tour. We will start the day a bit later than usual, providing you some free time.

New Incheon - Wolmido

Wolmido is an island located off the coast near Incheon and connected to the mainland by a highway or a monorail line. Thanks to its location near Seoul and the convenient transportation, it has become a weekend destination and tourist area with restaurants and cafes, theme park and the areas such as Meeting Square, Arts Square, Performance Square, Good Harvest Square, where spontaneous performances are performed, and street artists can draw for you on the spot.

Songdo Central Park

Songdo International Business District (Songdo IBD) is a new smart city built from scratch on 1,500 acres of reclaimed land along Incheon's waterfront. Songdo Central Park located in the center of this city serves to connect to various civic and cultural destinations by providing a seawater canal that refreshes itself every 24 hours. The park also displays sculpture and artwork such as the swooping neofuturistic metallic architecture of the Tri-Bowl.

Incheon Bridge

Completed in October 2009, the Incheon Bridge is a six-lane bridge linking Yeongjongdo (where the Incheon International Airport is located) and Songdo International City. It is the largest and longest bridge in Korea.

Depart to Incheon International Airport

You will be escorted by the guide to your check-in counter and receive your boarding pass and baggage claim ticket. Once checked in, you're free until your boarding time. Dinner in flight is not served until approximately 9pm.
