# **DETAILED ITINERARY**

# Day 1 – Departure (Meals: L, D Served during flight)

Check-in with your passport at Asiana Airlines counter located at Honolulu International Airport, Lobby 8.

## Asiana Airlines Flight OZ 231 Departs Honolulu at 11:20AM

# After you're reservation and final payment is made, you will be provided with our INFO PACKAGE that includes realtime flight schedule by data or wifi links and arrival information

Baggage allowance on Asiana Airlines is two (2) checkin baggage at or below fifty (50) pounds each and one (1) carryon. Any over limit baggage are incidental expense and you will be responsible for the charges. You will receive your boarding pass and baggage claim ticket after checking in.

# Day 2 – Welcome to KOREA! (Meals: D)

## Arrival to Incheon International Airport ETA 5:10 PM + 1 Day

After retrieving your baggage(s) and clearing customs you will be greeted by our coordinator. Please standby for all members arriving on the same flight to exit customs. Once the group is gathered, we will depart. We suggest that you use the restroom before our drive to Seoul. (Incheon to Seoul is approximately 1 hour and 15 min)

Arrival near East Gate (Dongdaemun) Market for dinner. After dinner, we will be spending some time at East Gate Market. This is where you can exchange US Dollars (Any currency) to Korean Won and tour the night market before our departure to Yangpyung.

## East Gate Market (Dongdaemun Market)

Is a large commercial district comprising traditional markets and shopping centers, specializing in wholesale and retail clothing. A full range of fashion items that cover head to toe, are found here at inexpensive prices. There are snack corners and night markets open during the time of our visit. East Gate Market to Hotel in Yangpyung is approximately 1 hour drive. We estimate that you'll be checking in late to your hotel.

# LAND PACKAGE member(s) arriving later than our scheduled group will need to meet at East Gate Market and depart with group to hotel.

# Day 3 - (Meals: B, L, D) - Bus departs 10am

## Bus will depart at 10am with all baggage loaded before departure.

## Garden of Morning Calm

The Garden of Morning Calm is the oldest private garden in Korea and houses about 5,000 kinds of plants, including 300 varieties native to Baekdusan Mountain, known as a spiritual mountain to the Korean people. Flowers are in bloom from March to November.

## Naminara Republic (Nami Island) - Ferry ride and admission included

Nami Island is a tiny half-moon shaped island located in Chuncheon formed as a result of the construction of Cheongpyeong Dam. There is the grave of General Nami, who led a great victory against the rebels in the Joseon Dynasty. The island, especially the Metasequoia path, was one of the main filming locations of the mega-hit Korean drama, Winter Sonata.

There are additional activities such as bike and Segway rentals along with train rides on the island. For more intense activities, there are zip lining and bungee jumping nearby the island. All activities are optional and your expense.

#### Daepohang Port

Located on the southern most point of Sokcho are the many raw fish restaurants and dried fish shops of Daepohang Port. This bustling port has become one of the most popular tourist spots for those in search of the freshest raw fish restaurants. The port is filled with raw fish restaurants and a live fish market containing eel, flatfish, flounder, yellowtail, and plethora of other high-end seafood.

# Day 4 - (Meals: B, L, D) - Bus Departs 9am

# On this day, we recommend that you prepare a light jacket or coat and shoes with good traction. Naksansa Temple

Naksansa Temple is located north of Naksan Beach and boasts a 1,300-year history. It was founded in 671 by Uisang, an ambassador of the 30th King of Silla Period (BC 57 - AD 935) after he returned from studying abroad during the Chinese Tang Dynasty. Naksansa is crowned by the Buddhist statue of Bodhisattva of Mercy, standing 49 feet high on 9.2 feet high pedestal.

#### Seoraksan National Park

The peaks of the Seorak Mountains break through the clouds while jade-like water flows through the valleys, creating breathtaking views and making this Korea's most famous national park. Due to the many rare species found here, UNESCO designated this national park a Biosphere Preservation District in 1982. Riding up and down the cable car, visitors can view the fascinating rock formations, and to the northeast even the East Sea comes into view.

#### Cheoksan Oncheon Jigu - Foot Spa

The Cheoksan hot springs water is known to be beneficial. Not only are the waters soft and great for your skin, but drinking the water is said to beautify the skin and improve blood circulation. The Cheoksan hot springs region is located a mere 10 minutes away Seorak Mountains, and is the perfect place to relax and relieve your fatigue.

## \*Sokcho to Seoul approximately 3 hour drive. Rest area stop provided.

#### N Seoul Tower

Seoul Tower is the highest point in Seoul metro area. The observatory offers panoramic views of Seoul and the surrounding areas. The letter 'N' stands for the tower's 'new' look, with a new lighting system and changes to the tower's overall color scheme, event coordinators can now decorate the tower for the season or events.

# Day 5 - (Meals: B, L, D) - Bus Departs 9am

#### Korean Folk Village

Visitors can experience the natural atmosphere with over 260 traditional houses reminiscent of the late Joseon Dynasty, including various household goods from different regions. All these features have been relocated and restored to provide visitors with a broad understanding of Korean food, clothing, and housing style of the past. In the Korean Folk Village, where the customs and lifestyles of the past generations have been carefully preserved, various lifestyles prevalent during the Joseon Dynasty can be seen.

#### **Everland Amusement Park**

The park is home to over 40 heart-pounding rides and attractions. In addition to "Safari World" featuring white tigers, tigers, lions and bears, "Lost Valley" opened in April 2013, letting visitors get up close and personal with the wild safari's giraffes, elephants and white lions riding on unique amphibious vehicles. Everland is also known for its gorgeous flower arrangements and beautiful gardens, which have been year-round fixtures. Everland recently opened its panda exhibit where you can view a real pandas!

#### Han River Cruise

This cruise is one of the best ways to enjoy the scenery around Han River that flows through Seoul. Cool wind from the river, the surrounding scenery, which get more beautiful in the evenings, are the rewards the ferry cruise can offer you. You will be getting on from Jamsil dock where city lights of Seoul and the latest Lotte Tower, the tallest tower in Korea can be viewed.

# Day 6 - (Meals: B, L, D) - Bus departs 9am

## Coex Mall - SMTOWN

COEX Mall is the largest underground shopping and entertainment complex in Asia. It is located in the basement of the Korea World Trade Center, located in Samseong-dong in the Gangnam-gu area of Seoul. SMTOWN at COEX Artium, opened in January 2015, is composed of SMTOWN STUDIO, a virtual space offering visitors a glimpse into the real educational experience of SM artists, cafe and theater, featuring a large-scale screen where visitors can enjoy a mix of holographic and live performances. \

#### Time Square Mall

Times Square is a large, comprehensive lifestyle complex equipped with various leisure, entertainment, accommodation, and dining establishments. The complex houses Shinsegae Department Store, which features a number of luxury brands and high-end local products, CGV Starium, which houses 12 movie theaters, including the world's largest screen, a multi-purpose performance center, Kyobo Book Center, E-Mart Discount Supermarket, provide perfect spots for relaxation and enjoying the nature inside the metropolitan complex.

## Hongdae (Hongik University Street)

Hongdae-ap is a neighborhood known for its youthful and romantic ambience, underground cultures, and freedom of self-expression. Unique cafes, cozy galleries, accessory stores, fashion shops, live cafés and clubs, art markets, and gourmet eateries make this a popular hang-out for locals in their 20s and 30s and a fascinating place to walk around. Hongdae-ap is an area that is always packed with people and excitement. *There is a cosmetic shop that offer FREE Hanbok (Korean traditional dress and attire) wearing activity.* 

## **DREAM CONCERT VIP Section**

Already on its 22nd year, the Dream Concert continues to be the largest K-pop music festivals in the world and features some of the biggest names in the K-pop industry every year. It will be held at the Seoul World Cup Stadium. Our group will be seated in the VIP section, very much the best seats in the house. We will provide dinner box set with drink. After you're seated, you can start your dinner and be ready for a spectacular show! (The show is estimated to be at least 4 hours in length)

# Concert is expected to end late and we may be getting back to our hotel after 11pm. We will delay our program for the following day. Bus departs at 12pm, next day to start your program.

# Day 7 - (Meals: B, L, D) - Bus departs 12pm

#### Shinsa-dong Garosu-gil

Adorned with ginkgo trees, Garosu-gil stretches less than a kilometer in Sinsa-dong, but is still considered a main area within the greater Gangnam area (business center in southeast Seoul). It's true that Garosu-gil boasts splendid scenery ginkgo trees, but it dazzles visitors mainly due to its collection of quaint stores and its unique bohemian atmosphere.

## Gangnam Station

Gangnam Subway Station area is the prime district for those living south of the Han River. Many people tend to gather at Gangnam Subway Station, as the location is geographically and commercially suitable as a meeting point for social gatherings, events or personal engagements. Hence, during the weekdays it is usually crowded in the evenings while on weekends, are often bustling with people.

## Insadong Market

Insadong is one of the most memorable attractions in Seoul and represents the focal point of Korean traditional culture and crafts. Stores in Insadong specialize in a wide variety of goods that can only be purchased or appreciated in Korea: hanbok (traditional clothing), hanji (traditional paper), traditional teas, pottery, and folk crafts.

## Gwanghwamun Square

Gwanghwamun Square is located at the center of Sejong-ro which connects Gwanghwamun Gate and Cheonggye Square. The square is divided into the sections, "Recovering the History of Gwanghwamun Gate Plaza," "Reenacting Yukjo Street Plaza," "Korea Main Plaza," "Civil Participation Urban Culture Plaza," "Downtown Plaza" and "Cheonggyecheon Stream Connector."

# Day 8 – Seoul / Incheon (Meals: B, L; Inflight: D, B) - Bus departs 4pm

FREE DAY - You can enjoy this day for yourself and visit areas that we have not included in our program. The hotel you're staying is located between Myeongdong Market and South Gate (Namdaemun) Market. We suggest these areas OR Gyeongbokgoong Palace down the street from your hotel. Either way, there's lots to do and see around where you're staying.

We will be loading from our hotel and ready to **depart to Incheon International Airport by 4pm**. Seoul to Incheon is approximately 1:15 hour drive.

You will be escorted to your check-in counter and receive your boarding pass and baggage claim ticket. After checking in, you'll be directed to entrance to security and immigration. You'll have some time to shop at Duty Free shops or retail stores. Dinner inflight may be later than usual but there are restaurants and snack shops after immigration.
