The Ethel Streit School is an educational program for homeschoolers and their families. Though some of our teachers hold valid teaching credentials, enrolled families are aware that we are not accredited as a school. It is the responsibility of our families to legally file their child as a homeschooler.

All curriculum materials will be supplied for classroom instruction. Additional fees may be charged for special projects or field trips.

Program Hours are Monday-Thursday from 9:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. At this time, neither before-care nor after-care are provided. Parents are responsible for sending in lunch and snack daily. At times, we will be cooking lunch together or preparing a special snack for the day. In such cases, we will notify families ahead of time, and you may choose whether or not to send additional food. Some of our students have food restrictions or allergies. We will make every effort to ensure children do not share food, however we are not an allergen-free classroom. If your child has specific restrictions or allergies, these must be noted on your child's admission health form.

We will be going outside daily, and your children will get dirty often! Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the day's weather, rain or shine, and for physical and/or artistic activities.

On the first day of school, please send your child with:

- a change of clothes, including socks and underwear
- child's preferred indoor footwear
- rain/snow boots

We value the health and well-being of all our students and staff. If your child develops a fever above 100.0 F while at school, vomits, or does not feel well enough to participate in the day's activities, they will be sent home, and cannot return until they have been fever-free (less than 100.0 F without medication) for 24 consecutive hours. We appreciate your caution and consideration around the wellness needs of our community.

Because our program includes frequent outdoor exploration and physical activity, some bumps and scrapes are to be expected. Our staff will promptly communicate more serious injuries at the time they occur, as well as communicate less serious injuries at the end of the school day.

Families are responsible for vaccinating their child according to Ohio Health Codes, and submitting proof of immunization for: diptheria, pertussis, tetanus, haemophilus b, measles, mumps, rubella, hepatitis b, varicella, meningococcal, and poliomyelitis.

An account is considered delinquent if not paid within 5 business days of the due date. A late payment fee of 2% per month will be charged on a delinquent account. If the delinquency is not resolved within an additional 30day period, the student may be dismissed. A fee of \$100.00 will be charged for all checks returned due to insufficient funds.

Tuition is not reduced for time away from school. The full monthly tuition is due regardless of days student has missed due to illness or vacation. The Ethel Streit School reserves the right to terminate enrollment at any time, if it is determined that: our program cannot effectively meet the needs of your child; your child is a danger to himself/herself or to others; or your child damages property on multiple occasions.
