- **Candy Gram Sales (Feb)** – in the days leading up to Valentine’s Day, the HSA sells Candy Grams for \$1 to students to give to their peers and teachers during lunch time. Help to sell these Candy Grams and/or assist the younger students with writing their message.
- **Mother’s Day Sale (May)** – on the Friday before Mother’s Day, the HSA sells various Mother’s Day goodies to students to take home to their favorite mom during lunch time and after school.

This permission will be applicable to any use of student information in the school year in which permission is given and will remain in effect until removed from the website or until consent is withdrawn. As parent or legal guardian, you may withdraw your consent at any time by sending a written letter, along with a new form, to the Principal of your child's school. Thank you for your cooperation.
