

## Home Viviting Programs of Stephenson County

These programs provide services to eligible families through home visits that help parents learn ways to improve their child's learning, development, and success in school.

We offer child development information and activities brought to the home by a trained professional. During these scheduled visits, the home visitor provides the parent with information on child development and answers questions the parents ask. Home visitors can help families connect to resources in the community. Age-appropriate parent/child activities are also provided at each visit. This also includes learning checkups to chart developmental milestones; ideas and activities that promote a child's learning; discussing family goals; and assisting children entering a preschool program at three years of age. Home visitors work with parents to help them understand their child's development and identify strengths and abilities, as well as areas of concern.

## Poula Services

Young parents meet with a Doula (labor coach). Together they discuss issues that concern a pregnant and/or parenting mom and dad, including labor and delivery, breastfeeding, and infant development. The Health Department offers prenatal classes, breastfeeding support groups, infant massage classes, and Happiest Baby on the Block training.

Studies show that children with home visitors are:

- Ready for school and less likely to drop out
- Have lower risk of substance abuse and behavior issues
- Have a lower risk of health problems, abuse or neglect

Being a parent is rewarding and challenging. Home visiting can help parents with this important job.



Want an evening filled with great conversation and new friends?

Parent cafes offer monthly conversations designed and led by parents. Topics may include helping your child be successful in school, single/step-parenting, budgeting, family activities, and much more.

Parents attending cafes also have the opportunity to develop and fine-tune their leadership skills in a variety of ways.

We provide a meal, childcare, and transportation for these events to make them as stress-free as possible for busy parents. We have various sites and times available.
