Who Are We?

Project Celebration began as a group of mothers concerned about teenage alcohol abuse and an increasing use of drugs in the 1980's. They addressed the issue by doing classroom drug education and promoting drug and alcohol free parties beginning at the fifth grade level all the way through to High School.

Awareness of the reasons kids use drugs and alcohol forced the group to become involved in the social changes that helped the community shift attitudes. Safe and Drug Free Schools and Communities and the Children's Trust Fund were two initial funders for projects and programs addressing the effect of chemical abuse and family violence.

Project Celebration now has a variety of programs geared toward helping families by providing services and links to services in communities throughout the Sabine Parish Area.

Services Available

Project Celebration is committed to helping individuals and families enhance their ability to live successfully in the community. Through education, advocacy and collaboration of all available resources consumers will develop the highest capacity for safety, self-reliance and personal well-being.

Services Available

Taylor House

Provides 24-hour crisis intervention, safety planning, emergency shelter, legal advocacy, support groups, individual and children services for survivors of domestic violence.

Family Resource Center

Provides parenting classes and counseling to children and adults. Clients are referred only through the Office of Community Services (OCS). There is no cost to eligible families.

Sexual Assault

Provides information and referrals for rape victims, 24-hour telephone counseling and in-office counseling for survivors of sexual assault, hospital and court escorts, support groups and community education.

Services Available

Addictive Disorder Outreach

Provides intensive and non-intensive outpatient therapy services, assessments, evaluations and recommendations for drug/alcohol treatment, gambling assessments and treatment, aftercare and referral services, counseling, support groups and inpatient referrals.

Anger Management

District Attorney's office refers individuals for individual and group therapy. Sessions provide anger management and life skills training for eligible individuals. Men and women groups are held separately.
