We are excited to have your teen join us on our annual Spring Retreat! The retreat will be held up at Camp Cedar Glen in Julian. It is one of the nicest retreat centers in the county boasting a rock-climbing tower, archery range, pool, Zip Line and more. This retreat will also welcome our Confirmation Class of 2019 and we are excited to have you join us!

What goes on: Retreat, by its very nature, is to get away from it all. Leave home, homework, TV, Computers, Cell Phones, FB, Texting, Sports, and the like behind.
