



WHEN COMPARING HUNT PRICES OF DIFFERENT OUTFITTERS...

Consider unexpected extras and compare advertised regular daily rates and trophy fees. Please look at the example below where I compared two packages for the same animals and number of days:

At first glance, the 10-day / 7 animal package-hunt offered by Outfitter "X" comes at a discount of **39%**. The same package with CT Safaris costs just under **\$1,000** more with a **15%** discount.

However, most hunters add animals to their packages once here and the example above shows that by adding one animal to the package, the cost of a hunt with CT Safaris will be the same as with Outfitter "X". If you were to add two extra animals, your hunt with Outfitter "X" will cost \$1,000 more than with CT Safaris and from there onwards you will progressively be paying more with Outfitter "X" than with CT Safaris.

These are important facts to consider if your main consideration is the total cost of your safari.
