

For years we attended our kid's sporting events. Like good parents everywhere, we cheered them on and met lots of other families in the process. While my middle son played water polo we had met a family who's son became best friends with our son. Naturally, we began seeing a lot of this new family. After games, we went to dinner and occasionally they'd come to our home or we would wind up at their home for a team party.

This went on for months. You would think through all this interaction we would know each other's names, right? Well, apparently I had gotten in my head that the father's name was Joe.
