Beloved,

I was four years old helping dad plant a garden in our backyard. I don't know if you ever did this but we had wooden pegs that we would pound into the ground around the garden and then we would get the string out and connect it from peg to peg about 4 to 6 inches above the ground. When finished, the string would be around the entire garden.

Planting the garden was special time for me to spend with my dad growing up, a great memory. And I was always so fascinated by watching the vegetables like tomatoes and onions and radishes growing from a small seed we planted in the ground. Just amazing!

As dad and I put the string around the garden, he asked me, "Do you know why we put a string around the garden, Johnny?" I said, "No." Dad went on to explain, "It's to keep little boys like you out of the garden." Without hesitation I quipped, "Little boys can jump over that string!"

I know, I know what you're thinking. That's our Father John. I was rebelling. Nobody is going to tell me where I can go and where I can't go because I'm large and in charge. Sadly but truly there is still so much of that rebellion in my heart. I want things my way and nobody, including God, is going to tell me different.

As you have heard me teach and preach many times, we are all only just beginning with God! God is a Mystery that will be forever unveiled to us and his desire for us is to grow in the experience of his unending love. You and I, right now, are only on the tip of the iceberg of who God is. If we rebel against his revelation, however, we die in our tracks.

God is calling us to listen more, submit to the ways of the Holy Spirit and stop doing things our way or what the rest of the culture is doing. So, how are you rebelling against his revelation in your life? Take some time and quiet, maybe in adoration at our chapel, and think about one thing that is troubling your conscience and what God is asking you to do. If you have a troubled conscience, you have a choice to rebel against God or say yes to his desires for you. And remember, while often it may not be easy it will always lead to life if we live the way of Christ. Otherwise, if we go where we want to go and leave Jesus behind we will be left all by ourselves and that sounds a lot like hell to me.

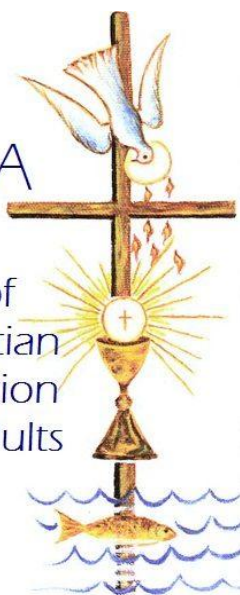

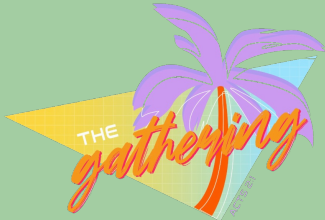
