Note From The Pastor

We have just one more Sunday of two worship services! Beginning on October 7th, Living Faith will worship as ONE faith, in ONE hope, through ONE Holy Spirit. Our schedule will change to include focus on small groups and learning opportunities as we begin our series entitled "ALL IN" by Mark Batterson. We will watch a short video, and then break into small groups for discussion and learning. It is our hope that a very large percentage of our members and regular attendees will give a small group a try! God, place on our hearts to be generous, good stewards with the resources You have entrusted to us, that we would freely and joyfully share with those in need and the church and its ministries. Amen.

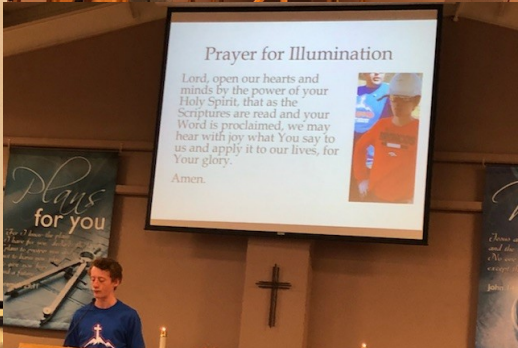
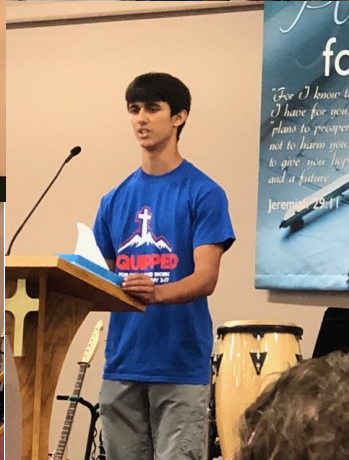
Pray the church to trust Jesus to grow the church, in His way and in His power
