From The Pastor

I like change. I do. I embrace it. Change is good. OK, I cope with all of these statements by reminding myself that “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.” Regardless of what changes we encounter today or in the future, we know we can count on God to be the same. I just really need to hear that and know that today. Scripture is so powerful in helping us through life and Scripture is so relevant to each of us. When life seems to be too weird, which to me is a lot of the time right now, I rely on knowing that my God never changes. Even though I can’t go to a store and try on a new shirt or take our grandkids to the park and watch them play, I can feel God’s presence and governance over each day.

Our leadership team made some tough choices at our Church Council meeting this week. We decided that the risk of inviting children into our building for VBS is too great so we will not be having VBS this summer. Handling personal items of others and inviting the public into our building to purchase the goods of others also seems like a great risk so we will not be having the rummage sale this summer. After discussion, we decided these rather easily. Not happily mind you, but easily because the risks seem so clear and the liability is great.

What we are struggling with is worship because all of us miss gathering and all of us miss each other! We have two more Sundays in May and we will be worshipping online for sure for these two Sundays. More than likely we will still be worshipping online into June. Although there are guidelines published by the CDC and also by the UMC, adhering to them and ensuring the protection of our people is daunting. This COVID 19 virus is real and it is contagious. We want to use our minds to make decisions with wisdom, not to make decisions based on fear.

Please know that I pray for each of you every single day. There has been some benefit to this extra quiet time for me and that has been deep and intentional prayer, much time spent in God’s Word as printed in The Holy Bible, and substantial time to quietly reflect on my life in Christ. I hope you are finding good uses of your extra time these days.

May 16, 2020

Richard gave a finance report:

- Currently mail-in or dropped off offerings are strong, approximately \$40,000 balance
- Operating expenses very low last month
- We received \$300 from United Methodist Foundation
- We receive a small business emergency grant (forgivable) for \$4,000
- We received Paycheck Protection from federal government (forgivable) for \$26,000
- Applied for and granted three months of reduced mortgage payments
- Requested we send out a message reminding people to continue giving, especially since we will not receive the typical income from the rummage sale since it is cancelled

Staffing: We remain at four paid staff (Sandy, Tom, Tracy, and Leah)

Mowing has begun, sprayed for dandelions and weeds, car hit one of the trees on our property (no one was hurt). Entire row of trees is dead, Courtney will get an estimate for cost to remove them.

Members are being cared for via phone calls, texts, emails, and mailings.

Special Events: Decided no VBS this summer and no rummage sale. Still discussing Car Show since it would be outside.


Tom asked that scouts be allowed to meet in our building in June. Gene motioned OK for scouts to meet as long as Tom sees that sanitizing practices are met and social distancing practiced. Courtney seconded. Vote was not unanimous, but it passed that scouts can meet.

SPRC meets Tuesday, May 26. Council suggested inviting Pastor Jaime to join this Zoom meeting and also to invite him to the June 16 Church Council meeting. Brief discussion of how to welcome Pastor Jaime and his family and also how to ensure closure with Pastor Sandy.

Joan asked for committee chairpersons to form a "Return to Worship" Team to plan and prepare for when and how we can worship together in the sanctuary. A date was not established.

Zoom meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
