It was such a blessing to hear our Youth group last Sunday. They were leading us throughout the worship service with songs, prayers, testimonies, and a video showing us their last mission trip activities at Camp Fontanelle. Indeed, last Youth Sunday Service was a joyful experience and Tom Earhart, their Youth Director, did a good job through his sermon as well. Thank you all for sharing your testimonies with us. We are so proud of you, and we praise our Lord for your lives.

This Sunday, I'm going to resume my sermon' series on Jonah's book, and I am going to share with you how this prophet represents in many ways the ministry and mission we Christians are called by God to fulfill nowadays here in our town, and all over the world as well.

According to Typology, (A term coming from Greek language, "typos") which is a form of biblical interpretation dealing with different people and places in the Bible, Jonah's character is a 'typo' or a copy, a sort of pattern or image, representing the church's mission into the world throughout history.

The story of Jonah gives us clear examples, or "signs" for the church living here and now, as a generation of Christian believers trying to run away from God in total rebellion and disobedience to His word. Yet, as it happened to Jonah when he had to face the consequences of his rebellion, the Lord had arranged for a great fish to swallow Jonah and to deliver him from dying under the sea. Which means, we all must go through repentance and confession of our sins before God. We must die to sin so that we may live for our Lord in faithful obedience to his Word.

Come and join us this Sunday to continue our traveling to Nineveh for the fulfillment of our mission throughout this Sermon's Series I will be preaching three Sundays in October. I pray for all of us, that the Word of God may speak to us and awake our spirit, so that we may be able to turn back to God in total surrender and obedience to his will.

Let us keep learning through Bible study more about Jesus Christ and his plan he has laid down for us. We may hear his voice calling us to follow him along the path of discipleship growing up each day until we become more like him.



We've thought about coming together for Fellowship and support, if needed, and then simply enjoying time while we work.





#### Supplies to have at home:

- Necessary medication ask healthcare provider about obtaining extra
  - o If extra is not possible consider using mail order
- Be sure to have over the counter medicines and medical supplies to treat fever and other symptoms
- Have enough household items and groceries on hand
  - o Grocery stores with 'at-risk' hours
  - Consider ways of getting food brought to your house











#### **Everyday Precautions**

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
  - o If soap and water is not available use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol
- Avoid touching high touch surfaces in public places (elevator buttons, door handles, handrails, handshaking, etc)
- Avoid touching your face, nose, eyes, etc.
- Clean and disinfect your home to remove germs
- · Stay home as much as possible























#### Symptoms and emergency warning signs:

- · Pay attention to COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, and shortness of breath
- Emergency warning signs:
  - 0 Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
  - Persistent pain or pressure in chest
  - o New confusion or inability to arouse
  - Bluish lips or face

- Consult with your health care provider for more information
- · Stay in touch with others by phone or email
- Determine who can care for you if your caregiver gets sick
- Know when to get emergency help
