From The Pastor

We have already resumed the sermon' series "The Signs of Jonah," and this Sunday we will learn about the third chapter of Jonah's book. The sermon's title is "The Sign of Salvation." It will be about Jonah's prophetic ministry in Nineveh. When the Word of the LORD came to Jonah a second time, he obeyed the divine command and went to preach a warning message in a period of 40 days. 'Forty' is a word used several times in the Old Testament writings. It just means an indefinitely large amount of days. It is like the term 'dozens' in English. The entire people of Nineveh heard Jonah's preaching as a way of warning of God's judgment upon them: "Forty days from now Nineveh will be destroyed!" Repentance was the only chance for the entire city.

So, since the first day when the people and the king of Nineveh heard Jonah's message, repentance broke out and even the king stepped down from his throne and proclaimed fasting and sackcloth by decree throughout the city. Even the animals from herds and flocks were forced to avoid food and water. The Ninevites' repentance was genuine, and God did not carry out the destruction he had threatened.

Prayerfully consider coming this Sunday to worshipping our God. We all follow the social distancing guidelines at church in compliance with the CDC regulations. Come and join us as you are able, and if you feel comfortable participating in corporate worshipping. Music and songs have been a blessing for all of us. The praise team are leading us with joyful songs into God's presence. Prayer, Scriptures reading, and sermon are bringing an inspirational environment as well. Last Sunday we celebrated Holy Communion and together we remembered our Lord and Savior sacrifice on the cross. Also, we had two new families visiting our church whose kids liked so much participating on our Sunday School program. We were so blessed by the Holy Spirit presence among us.

This month we will be working on the Charge Conference reports. Our Finance Committee is going to prepare the budget for next year. All teams and committees are going to work on their goals for 2021 year as well. Let us keep praying for our congregation and our community at Millard area. 



We've thought about coming together for Fellowship and support, if needed, and then simply enjoying time while we work.





Supplies to have at home:

- Necessary medication – ask healthcare provider about obtaining extra
 - If extra is not possible – consider using mail order
- Be sure to have over the counter medicines and medical supplies to treat fever and other symptoms
- Have enough household items and groceries on hand
 - Grocery stores with 'at-risk' hours
 - Consider ways of getting food brought to your house



Everyday Precautions

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
 - If soap and water is not available – use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol
- Avoid touching high touch surfaces in public places (elevator buttons, door handles, handrails, handshaking, etc)
- Avoid touching your face, nose, eyes, etc.
- Clean and disinfect your home to remove germs
- Stay home as much as possible



Symptoms and emergency warning signs:

- Pay attention to COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, and shortness of breath)
- Emergency warning signs:
 - Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
 - Persistent pain or pressure in chest
 - New confusion or inability to arouse
 - Bluish lips or face



If you get sick

- Stay home and call your doctor
- Consult with your health care provider for more information
- Stay in touch with others by phone or email
- Determine who can care for you if your caregiver gets sick
- Know when to get emergency help
