



Bulk Trash Day

May 22, 2021- May 23, 2021

Saturday 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. – Sunday 9 a.m. to noon.

First come, first serve – or until containers are full!

Program change! Residential customers only!

One trip per utility account, per vehicle- no exceptions.

MAX – 5 cubic yards (example: a stove is = 1 cubic yard)

- **Utility Bill must be presented at the time of disposal.** (Utility Bill must indicate garbage service is provided. This service is not intended for people who live outside the city limits) **This is Required!**
- Drop off location: Sewer plant – **2110 W Hwy 29**
 - Limbs must be bundled no more than 4 feet long
 - Separate metals, scrap lumber, limbs & brush from each other!
 - No hazardous materials will be accepted: NO CFL florescent bulbs, chemicals, oil or filters, refrigerant left in items, fiberglass boats, electronic equipment, rock, dirt or construction debris of any kind. Etc... If unsure, contact City Hall for answers.
- We will help dispose of automobile tires with a \$3.00 charge per tire. Tires must be off the rim. Tires on rims will NOT be accepted. Only car or pick-up truck tires will be accepted. Fee can be paid in advance or on disposal site.
- Please be prepared to unload unwanted items.
- Rain make up day to be determined!
- PLEASE REMEMBER THE CITY IS GROWING AND THIS A FREE SERVICE WITH LIMITED DUMPSTER CAPACITY. Please be courteous and follow the guidelines. We will continue to monitor what improvements we can make as we grow.
