Required documentation:

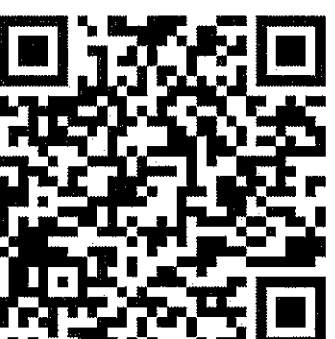
- ID
 - U.S. Citizenship/Legal Residence
 - 30-Day Income History
 - Vendor Release
 - Current Bill with Balance
- *Other forms are required for special circumstances.

Funding Available

We still have funding available for 2020. If you apply now and are approved, you will qualify for energy assistance through the rest of the year.
