Planning and Zoning Commission: (PZ)

Number of Positions: 5

Purpose: The purpose and objective of the Planning & Zoning Commission (PZ) is to act as an advisory board of the City Council in matters relating to the City's Zoning & Subdivision Ordinances. Ideal appointments for consideration should have some experience in building, zoning and subdivisions. Must live in the City limits of Bertram. **Meeting:** The P&Z meets on the 3rd Monday of every month at 6:00pm at City Hall. Currently the role of P&Z Commission is assumed by the City Council due to lack of community participation.

Bertram Economic Development Corporation (EDC)

Number of Positions: 5

Purpose: The BEDC serves as a catalyst to build wealth for all Bertram citizens by assisting existing and prospective industry to increase revenues generated in this area. Success is measured by job creation and retention, tax base increases and other important objectives related to economic development. Ideal appointments will be made to applicants who understand economic development, job creation, retention and the generation of sales tax. Applicants must live in the city limits of Bertram, Burnet County, or 10 miles from City limits. **Meeting:** The BEDC meets on the 1st Monday of every month at 5:00pm at City Hall

Municipal Development District (MDD)

Number of Positions: 3

Purpose: The BMDD serves as a catalyst to build wealth for all Bertram citizens by assisting existing and prospective industry to increase revenues generated in this area. Success is measured by job creation and retention, tax base increases and other important objectives related to municipal development. Must live in the city limits of Bertram. **Meeting:** The MDD meets as needed as needed at called times at Bertram City Hall.

Board of Adjustment & Appeals Commission (BOA)

Number of Positions: 5

Purpose: The BOA makes special exceptions to the terms of the City's Zoning Ordinance that are consistent with the general purpose and intent of the ordinance and in accordance with any applicable rules contained in the ordinance. Members are responsible for hearing and deciding applications for special permits; appeals or variances from the terms of the Zonings ordinance. Application must live in the City limits of Bertram. **Meeting:** The MDD meets as needed once a month at 7:00pm at Bertram City Hall. Currently the role of BOA is assumed by City Council due to lack of community participation.

How to Apply: Any person who desires to be considered for appointment for any position must complete an Application for Appointment to City Boards and Commission. These positions are non-paid.
