“Finishing Well”

Years ago, while working on my Master’s degree from Southwestern Christian University out of Oklahoma City, OK, I took a Spiritual Formation course under Dr. Bobby Clinton Jr. Dr. Clinton was a long-time professor at Fuller Theological Seminary in California. He first began to teach there in 1981.

Dr. Clinton has written numerous leadership publications such as “Focused Lives (1995) Connecting: The Mentoring Relationships You Need to Succeed in Life (1992), and The Making of a Leader” (1989)

But one of Leadership Publications that Dr. Clinton shared with our class was called “**Finishing Well.**” Dr. Clinton had done a study of at least 800 leaders of the bible and what he discovered was that only one third of those leaders finished well.

It was in that moment, that I made up my mind, that with God’s help, I would do everything that I could to make sure that I finished well. That is my heart’s desire and daily prayer.

Dr. Clinton shared with our class, six positive characteristics that all successful leaders that finished well, had in their lives.

- 1. They maintain a personal and vibrant relationship with God until the very end.**
- 2. They maintain a learning posture and can learn from various kinds of sources-life especially.**
- 3. They manifest Christ-likeness in character, as evidenced by the Fruit of the Spirit.**
- 4. Truth is lived out in their lives so that, convictions and promises of God are seen to be real.**
