

2020 COVID-19 Guidelines at Ridgefield Arena



COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The following COVID-19 Guidelines must be adhered to when competing and/or attending Ridgefield Shows. In addition, all Federal, State and local laws that may be applicable must be followed. Management reserves the right to change the guidelines when/if it is necessary. The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to the virus. (See www.cdc.gov or <https://showmestrong.mo.gov/>)

If you plan to come to the Ridgefield Show, you must assure that neither you, nor anyone in your household has or is:

1. Tested positive or been presumed positive for COVID-19 at any time during the past 14 days.
 2. Been advised by a healthcare professional to self-quarantine at any time during the past 14 days.
 3. Been in close physical contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has been presumed positive for COVID-19, during the past 14 days
 4. Subject to a quarantine order or a recommendation of a healthcare professional that in either case, would make it inadvisable to attend a public event or competition.
 5. Within the past 24 hours, exhibited any of the following symptoms: fever of 99.9 or greater, cough, shortness of breath.
- Please follow social distancing guidelines. Respect the ones around you.
 - All personnel must check their temperature prior to arriving on the show grounds. Personnel with a temperature of 99.9 or greater should not attend the Horse Show.
 - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 30 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
 - Please **frequently clean and disinfect** all tack, equipment, and surfaces that others may come in contact with. This includes hoses, tack trunks, reins, halters, lead ropes, and other common items used during show attendance.



- Please use trash receptacles, so that staff does not have to come in contact with contaminated items that are not discarded properly. DO NOT LITTER.
- All exhibitors and attendees are responsible for monitoring their own personal and family health prior to, during and after attending the horse show.
- **Trainers will be held responsible** for the conduct and adherence to the rules and guidelines set forth during the horse show. Please discuss with each individual in your group the importance of following rules and the direction of the horse show staff.
- All vehicles and trailers entering the competition grounds may be subject to being stopped for horse show guidelines.
- All vehicle occupants must obtain a copy of the current COVID-9 horse show guidelines and a COVID-19 release form that must be signed and acknowledged prior to entering the horse show grounds. The COVID-19 release form must be signed before an exhibitor can compete.

- The **horse show office** will have specific procedures that will be posted and announced during the event. No more than one person will be allowed in the show office at one time. -online entry, and riders will be automatically checked out after the show with the method of payment left.
- Adds and Scratches must be texted to the office at 314-282-4148 prior to the end of the class. Notify gate that that has been completed prior to riding.
- Please don't crowd the **ingate area**. Specific presentation procedures for collection of awards and ribbons will be announced prior to and during the show.
- Management will provide daily guidance for attendees to address issues such as awards, distribution, office and entry policies as well as other important guidelines and announcements pertinent to the daily activities.
- Thank you for your compliance and assistance in keeping the Ridgefield Showm our families and staff as safe as possible. We welcome the opportunity to return to showing and need everyone's cooperation and understanding to make this event work. Ridgefield Arena management and staff will do everything we can to ensure a safe and enjoyable horse show. Stay safe and don't hesitate to contact management or staff with any questions during this difficult time in our lives and sport.
