We are a community of believers called by God to live humbly in the spirit of Christ and to act as His voice and hands in our world.

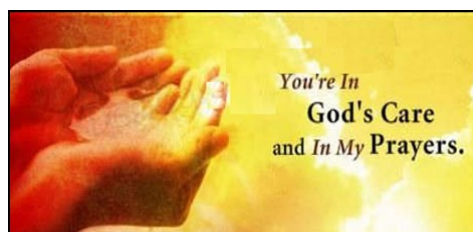
FPC Blesses the Animals on Saturday, Nov. 14

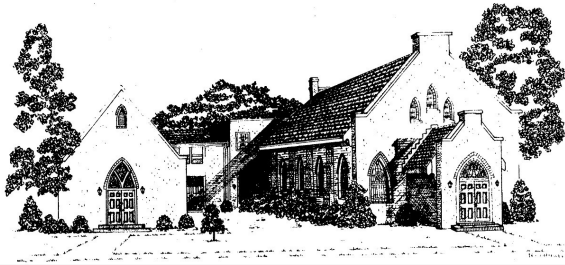

- Heard the report of the commissioners to the October 27 presbytery meeting;
- Approved canceling the December Session meeting and handling any required business via electronic votes or called meetings.

Sugar Coated Pecans

Ingredients:

1 egg white
1 tablespoon water
1 pound pecan halves
1 cup white sugar
3/4 tsp salt
1/2 tsp ground cinnamon

Preheat oven to 250°.
Grease one baking sheet (parchment paper can be used).
In a mixing bowl, whip together the egg white and water until frothy.
In a separate bowl, mix together sugar, salt and cinnamon.
Add pecans to egg whites, stir to coat the nuts evenly.
Remove the nuts, and toss them in the sugar mixture until coated.
Spread the nuts out on the prepared baking sheet.
Bake at 250° for 1 hour, stirring every 15 minutes.
