Theological Questions

Last week's question:

Does the Bible refer to the Church as "the Bride of Christ"?

There are many places in the Old Testament where the Lord God speaks to his People as his bride. The People of Israel had entered with God into a Covenant, like a marriage covenant.

"For your husband is your Maker; the Lord of hosts is his name," (Is 54:5)

"I remember the devotion of your youth, how you loved me as a bride." (Jer 2:2)

The prophets Hosea, Jeremiah and Ezekiel speak of Israel as an unfaithful bride, unfaithful to her Covenant with God. But God remains faithful.

In the New Testament, the same imagery is used for the Church. Jesus taught by many parables that the Kingdom of God is like a "wedding feast" (see Mt 22:1-14; Mt 24:1-14), and Jesus performed his first miracle at a wedding feast (Jn 2:1-11). John the Baptist called Jesus "the bridegroom."

Jesus said that his disciples could not fast "as long as the bridegroom is with them." St. Paul told the Corinthians that they are "espoused to one husband" (1 Co 12:2-4). St. Paul speaks of marriage in comparison to the relationship of Christ with his bride the Church (Eph 5:23,32). Above all, the book of Revelation speaks of the Church as "the bride of the Lamb", and of Heaven as an eternal wedding feast:

"I saw the holy city, a new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband" (Rev 21:2).

"Blessed are those who have been called to the wedding feast of the Lamb" (Rev 19:9).

New Question: Is it necessary to have a wedding ring in order to receive the sacrament of Marriage?
