**Theological Questions**

**Last week's question: What are the words for the exchange of consent in the Catholic Rite of Marriage?**

The words spoken by the groom and by the bride are as follows: **"I, [Name], take you, [Name], to be my wife/husband. I promise to be true to you in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health. I will love you and honor you all the days of my life."**

An alternative version is: **"I, [Name], take you, [Name], for my lawful wife/husband, to have and to hold from this day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and health, until death do us part."**

If, however, it seems preferable for pastoral reasons, the priest may obtain consent from the couple through questions:

**"[Name], do you take [Name] to be your wife/husband? Do you promise to be faithful to her/him in good times and in bad, in sickness and in health, to love her/him and to honor her/him all the days of your life?"**

The bridegroom and the bride each reply: **"I do."**
