Theological Questions

Last week's question: Does the Bible ever compare the voice of God to "thunder"?

Yes. Although there are places where God's voice is described as gentle or soft (see 1 Kings 19:12 and Exodus 33:11), there are also numerous places in the Old and New Testaments that compare his voice to thunder. Here are a few:

Ps 29:3 - The voice of the Lord is over the waters; the God of glory thunders

Job 37:4 - Again his voice roars, his majestic voice thunders

2 Sm 22:14 - The Lord thundered from heaven; the Most High made his voice resound.

Ez 43:2 - His voice was like the roar of many waters

Mt 3:16-17 - After Jesus was baptized ... a voice came from the heavens, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

Jn 12:28 - Then a voice came from heaven, "I have glorified my name and will glorify it again." The crowd there heard it and said it was thunder; but others said, "An angel has spoken to him."

The voices of the angels are often described as sounding like thunder:

Rev 6:2 - and I heard one of the four living creatures cry out in a voice like thunder

Rev 10:4 - and then [the angel] cried out in a loud voice as a lion roars. When he cried out, the seven thunders raised their voices, too.

New Question: Who was Pope Paul VI?
