Theological Questions

Last week's question:

What did Vatican II say about Gregorian chant?

The repertory of ancient Latin liturgical music is often called "Gregorian" in honor of St. Gregory I, who was the pope from 590 until 604. Although Gregory did much to promote the sacred liturgy, there was already a long tradition of "Old Roman" Latin plainchant, and the repertory would continue to develop up until the thirteenth century. The use of simple harmonies (organum) and more elaborate "polyphony" grew very gradually out of the tradition of Gregorian chant.

The Second Vatican Council said,

"The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services.

"But other kinds of sacred music, especially polyphony, are by no means excluded from liturgical celebrations, so long as they accord with the spirit of the liturgical action." (SC 116)

New Question: What is polyphony?

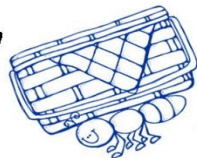
