**Theological Questions**

**Last week's question:**

**When was the naval Battle of Lepanto? Who won?**

**Answer:** In the year 1571, the Moslem Ottoman Empire assembled a large fleet, intending to invade Italy. With Christian Europe divided between Protestants and Catholics, the Turkish forces could easily have taken over a large part of Europe with little opposition. A small Christian naval force, called the Holy League, mostly from Venice and Spain, under the leadership of Don John of Austria, met the Ottoman fleet near Lepanto, in the Gulf of Patras in Greece. Pope St. Pius V called upon all Christians to say the Rosary for protection against the invading forces. The Battle took place on October 7, 1571. Against overwhelming odds, the Christian fleet repelled the attack and defeated the invasion. In thanksgiving, the pope established October 7<sup>th</sup> as the feast of Our Lady of Victories, later re-named the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. Catholics observe the whole month of October as a time of special devotion to the Rosary.


