There are many ways to express our contrition, or sorrow for our sins, and so there are variations in the exact wording of this prayer. One version is as follows:

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell; but most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all-good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to avoid the near occasions of sin.
Amen.

What are the requirements for confessing our sins in the sacrament of Penance?
