BACKGROUND OF

OUR CURRENT ORGAN

The organ was a gift (received around fall of 1997) from St. Catherine of Siena in Great Falls at no cost to our parish except for shipping, installation, and preparation to make it functional at St. Andrews.

In the fall of 2017 the existing organ experienced a series of mechanical issues which continued even after several repair attempts. In December 2017, it was determined to be unusable. Since mid-December, the parish has operated with a leased electronic instrument.



Our parish has a 25+ year history of beautiful sacred music. In order to continue to support the choirs and congregation in the worship of God, through the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, a new organ must be purchased.
