Theological Questions

Last week's question:

Was St. John the Baptist from the tribe of Levi or the tribe of Judah?

He was from the tribe of Levi, on both sides of his family. The Gospel of St. Luke says about his parents, "There was a priest named **Zechariah** of the priestly division of Abijah; his wife was from the daughters of Aaron, and her name was **Elizabeth**" (Lk 1:5).

Levi was the third son of Jacob, and Judah was the fourth son. Moses and his brother Aaron were from the tribe of Levi. The Jewish priests, who offered sacrifices in the Temple, were descendants of Aaron. **Aaron** had four sons and twenty-four grandsons. (1 Chronicles 24:1-19). Abijah was one of the grandsons of Aaron, and Zechariah was descended from Abijah.

As the son of Zechariah, St. John the Baptist was also a member of the tribe of Levi, and a descendant of Aaron, and, therefore, also a priest.

New Question: Who was the woman who started the annual March for Life, beginning on January 22, 1974?

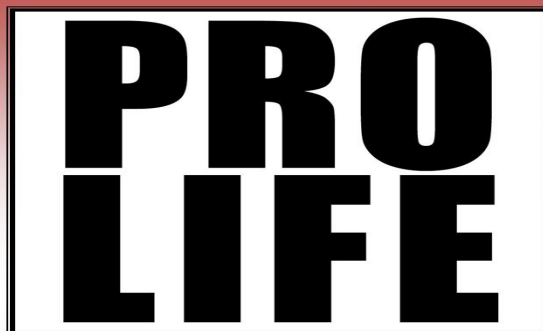
