Theological Questions

Answer to last week's question: What is the newest parish in the Diocese of Arlington?

The parish of **St. Bridget of Ireland in Berryville** (Clarke County) was established as the 70th parish in the Diocese of Arlington on July 12, 2017. It had been a mission of Sacred Heart of Jesus in Winchester since 1999. The church building was dedicated in 2002.

The parish of **Corpus Christi in South Riding** was established as the 69th parish in the diocese of Arlington in 2014. It had been a mission of St. Stephen the Martyr parish in Middleburg since 2000. It has not yet built a permanent church building. It currently holds Sunday Masses at John Champe High School in Aldie, Va. The **newest church building** in the Diocese is **St. Jude Catholic Church in Spotsylvania** County, which was dedicated on July 18, 2018. It was begun as a mission of St. Mary in Fredericksburg in 2003, and it was established as a separate parish in 2007.

There is another new Catholic Church, **St. Jude Syro-Malabar Catholic Church in Chantilly**, which was established on February 16, 2019. Fr. Justin Puthussery is the pastor. Although it is located within the territory of the Diocese of Arlington, it belongs to the Syro-Malabar Catholic Diocese of St. Thomas in Chicago. Before they had their own building, St. Jude Mission held Sunday Masses here at St. Andrew the Apostle from July 3, 2016 until February 10, 2019.

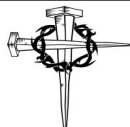
Our Lady of Fatima Presentation - May 11
