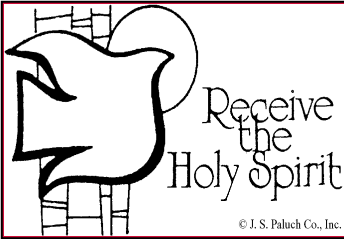

Theological Questions

Last week's question: What is a missionary?

"A person who is sent by Church authority to preach the Gospel, or help strengthen the faith already professed, among people in a given place or region. Essential to being a missionary, whether at home or abroad, is the desire to extend the Kingdom of Christ by preaching, teaching, or other means of evangelization and catechesis."

(John Hardon, *Modern Catholic Dictionary*).

In the spirit of the Apostles, certain persons are specially commissioned and sent to places, often far from their homelands, to evangelize people who have never known Christ and his Church. However, the missionary mandate belongs to the entire Church, and every member of the Church must take part in the missionary character of the Church.

"Having been divinely sent to the nations that she might be 'the universal sacrament of salvation,' the Church, in obedience to the command of her founder and because it is demanded by her own essential universality, strives to preach the Gospel to all men": "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and Lo, I am with you always, until the close of the age." (Catechism, 849).
