Theological Questions

Last week's question: What is apologetics?

Apologetics is the defense and explanation of the faith against objections. In its original meaning, an "apology" is not an admission of fault, but a systematic defense or argument in favor of one's beliefs and practices. One of the earliest writings of the early church is St. Justin's Apology, in which he explained and defended Christianity to the educated and skeptical pagans of the Roman Empire. The autobiography of John Henry Newman is called the Apologia Pro Vita Sua (literally, a defense of his life), written in response to certain hostile critics. Cardinal Newman explained in detail his reasons for leaving the Church of England and for entering the Catholic Church in 1845.

Apologetics is a necessary part of teaching the faith, because the articles of the faith must be shown to be reasonable and credible, and objections must be answered, so that those who deny or oppose the faith can be persuaded to accept it.

New Question: What is "orthodoxy"?
