Theological Questions

Last week's question: What is the Act of Contrition?

This is a prayer by which we express our sorrow for our sins. We need to make an Act of Contrition when we go to Confession, before we receive absolution. It is a good practice to examine our conscience and to say an Act of Contrition every day as part of our daily prayers. Psalm 51 is sometimes called King David's "act of contrition" when he repented from his sins of adultery and murder. A more familiar version of the Act of Contrition is:

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of Heaven and the pains of Hell, but most of all because I have offended You, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Your grace, to confess my sins, to do penance, and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.

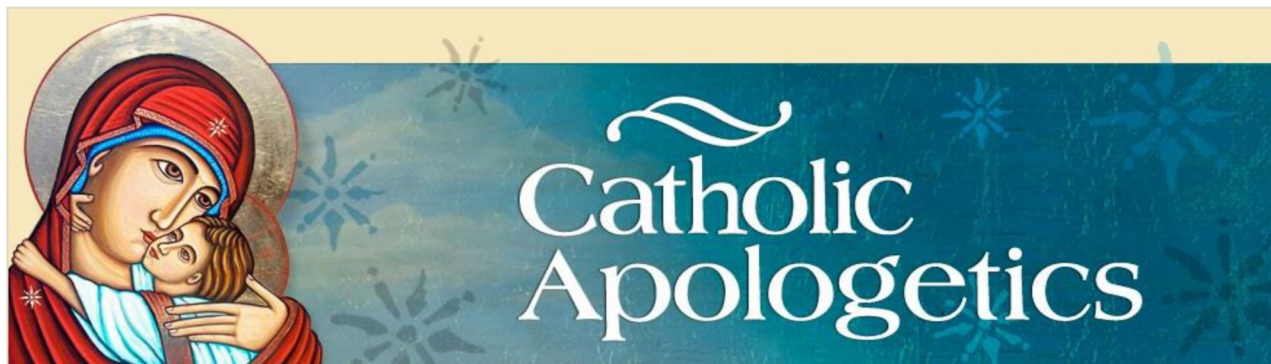
**Pro-Life Summer Seminar:
