### Theological Questions

**Last week's question: What are the names of the twelve Apostles?** The names of the twelve apostles are these: first Simon, now known as **Peter**, and his brother **Andrew**; **James**, Zebedee's son, and his brother **John**; **Philip** and **Bartholomew**, **Thomas** and **Matthew** the tax collector; **James**, son of Alphaeus, and **Thaddeus (Jude)**; **Simon** the Zealot and **Judas Iscariot**, who betrayed him. (See Matthew 10:2-5, Mark 3: 16-19, Luke 6:12-16 and Acts 1:13)

After Jesus ascended into Heaven, the Apostles chose **Matthias** to replace Judas, who had killed himself (See Acts 1:26).

One way to remember their names is to remember the acronym BAPTISM (let the I stand for the J, as it does in Greek and Latin): **B** (Bartholomew); **A** (Andrew); **P** (Peter, Philip); **T** (Thomas); **I** (James, John, James, Jude, Judas); **S** (Simon); **M** (Matthew and Matthias).
