Theological Questions

Last week's question:

Why is Church law called "canon law"?

The Greek word kanon means "rod" or "rule". In general, therefore, a "canon" is a rule or precept or law or an official standard. We speak of the "canon" of Scripture, meaning the official list of books in the Bible; saints are "canonized" when their names are added to the official list of saints in the Church. In many Church documents, when an official rule is stated, it is called a "canon" (for example, the doctrinal or disciplinary canons issued by the Council of Nicaea or by the Council of Trent). The whole collection of laws issued by the Church over the centuries is called Canon Law. The laws of the Church were codified into a single book in 1917 in the Code of Canon Law. The Code of Canon Law was revised and reissued in 1983 by Pope John Paul II. The present Code of Canon Law has a total of 1752 canons. Many of these canons are simply expressions of Divine Law, the law of God, as we discover it in Divine Revelation, in Scripture and Tradition. God's laws cannot be changed. But some canons are matters of discipline and prudence, and can be revised at times (for example, how long one should fast before receiving Holy Communion).

New Question:

What does Canon Law say about fasting before receiving Holy Communion?
