Theological Questions

Last week's question:

What are the seven capital sins (also called the seven deadly sins)?

Theologians traditionally identify seven “**root causes**” or leading tendencies that generally incline our fallen human nature toward sin. Every sin and vice is rooted in one or more of these “capital” sins. The word “capital” comes from the Latin word, *capita*, meaning “head” or “principal”. They are sometimes called the seven “deadly” sins, not because they are necessarily grave sins in every case, but because they are the tendencies toward sins which can deprive us of eternal life. The capital sins are **pride, avarice (greed), lust, envy, gluttony, anger and sloth (laziness).**

New Question:

What are the virtues that correspond to the seven capital sins? See next week's bulletin for the answer.

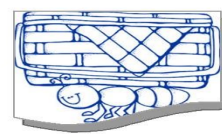

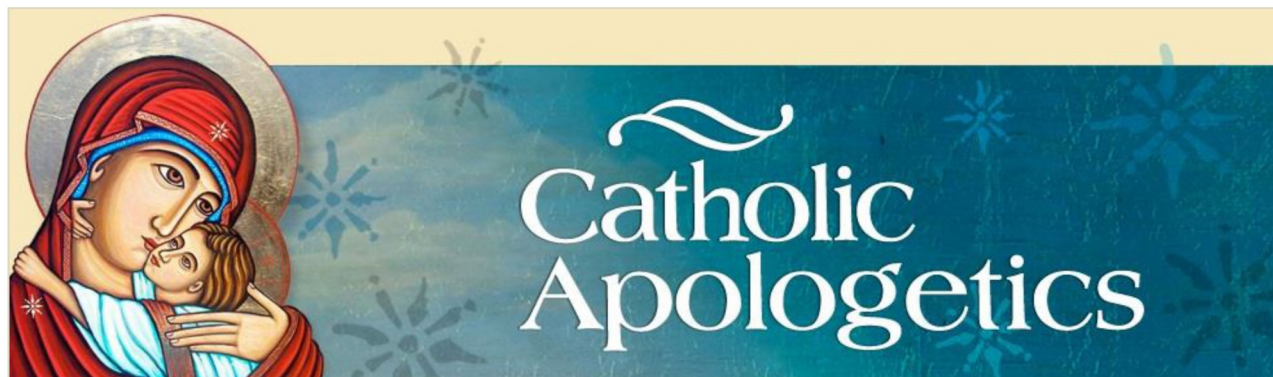
