Theological Questions

Last week's question: On an organ, what is a "stop"?

In a pipe organ, each set of pipes is called a "rank". If there are 61 keys on the organ manual, there would be 61 pipes in each rank. There may be multiple ranks controlled by each manual (or keyboard). Each rank has a different timbre or sound, like the different instruments in an orchestra. There are four general categories (principal, string, reed and flute), but there are many possible variations within each category.

The organist can choose which ranks to play by pulling out the "stops", which are knobs on the organ console. The organist can "stop" the flow of air to other ranks of pipes by pushing in the stops. To "pull out all the stops" would mean to use all of the different ranks of pipes at the same time.

New Question: In musical notation, what is a "staff"?




