## Theological Questions

### Last week's question: What is evangelization?

It refers to proclaiming the message of Jesus to the world, or teaching the Gospel. The English word "**Gospel**" (derived from the ancient Anglo-Saxon word, "God-spel"), is the translation of the Greek word Euangelion (Evangelium in Latin), which literally means "good news" or "glad tidings." In general, one who teaches the Gospel is called an evangelist. More specifically, the Four Evangelists are the authors of the Gospels in the New Testament, Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Evangelization is the missionary work of the Church, which began when Jesus sent forth his Apostles, saying, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age (Matthew 28:19-20)."

The task of evangelization belongs to every Christian.
