Last week's question: In which baseball stadiums in the United States have popes celebrated Mass?

Pope Paul VI celebrated Mass on October 4, 1965 at Yankee Stadium in New York City.

Pope John Paul II celebrated five Masses: October 2, 1979 at Yankee Stadium in New York; October 3, 1979 at Shea Stadium in New York; October 8, 1995 at Orioles Stadium at Camden Yards in Baltimore; September 16, 1987 at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles, September 18, 1987 at Candlestick Park in San Francisco

Pope Benedict XVI celebrated Mass on: April 17, 2008, at Nationals Park in Washington, DC; April 20, 2008, Yankee Stadium in New York. (Pope John Paul II celebrated several other Masses at football stadiums, but this theological question is only about baseball).

New Theological "Baseball" Question: Who is the Catholic bishop (or archbishop) in each of the cities playing in this year's World Series?

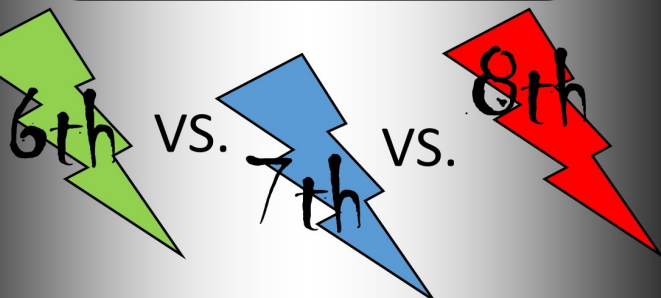
