Theological Questions

Last week's question: In music, what is meant by the tempo? What notation is used to indicate the tempo?

Tempo is the speed at which music is sung or played, or how many **beats per minute**. This is a variable that may depend on individual tastes or the situation.

A composer may indicate how quickly or slowly a piece of music is to be played with an Italian inscription at the beginning of the piece. Some examples:

Grave – very slow (25–45 bpm)

Largo – broadly (40–60 bpm)

Lento – slowly (45–60 bpm)

Larghetto – rather broadly (60–66 bpm)

Adagio – slowly with great expression (66–76 bpm)

Andante – at a walking pace (76–108 bpm)

Moderato – at a moderate speed (108–120 bpm)

Allegro – fast, quickly, and bright (120–156 bpm)

Vivace – lively and fast (156–176 bpm)

Presto – very, very fast (168–200 bpm)

The tempo can affect the mood of a song, or even its meaning.

A slow bugle call, like “Taps” at a funeral, evokes sadness and solemnity, while “Reveille” is a fast, rousing call to “wake up.”

Some hymns would naturally be sung at a faster tempo (like “Joy to the World”). Others (like “Silent Night”) are sung at a slower tempo, as a meditation, or a lullaby.

It is quite common to slow down the tempo a little (called **Ritardando**) at the conclusion of a song.

**November 25 Bulletin

The Virginia Attorney General announced on Oct. 24 that he will be investigating allegations of sexual abuse of minors by clergy as well as how allegations of abuse have been handled by Church leaders throughout the Commonwealth. Our Bishop and Bishop Knestout of the Diocese of Richmond recently published a statement addressing the investigation. On the diocesan website you will find resources as well as detailed answers to frequently asked questions regarding the critical issues we are facing within our Church. Lastly, on Oct. 26, Bishop Burbidge published an episode of The Walk Humbly Podcast, during which he directly addresses the investigation and some of the questions he has received. All these resources are available at ArlingtonDiocese.org/ChildProtection. In addition to fervent prayer for all victims of sexual abuse, please also offer your prayers that the Church will be purified and made stronger by recommitting to greater accountability and continuing to work for the good of God's people.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

The U.S. bishops are joining together in a commitment of prayer and reparation leading up to the bishops' General Assembly (November 12 – 15), where we will be making critical decisions in response to the clergy sexual abuse crisis. With my brother bishops across the nation, I will be dedicating myself to seven days of intensified prayer and fasting, from Monday, November 5, through Sunday, November 11. The intentions for this period of prayer and sacrifice are three-fold:

- *For the healing and support of all victims of clergy sexual abuse.*
- *For the conversion and just punishment of the perpetrators and concealers of sexual abuse.*
- *For the strength of the bishops to be holy shepherds in protecting and leading their sheep from all harm.*

If you feel called to do so, you are welcome to join me in praying for these intentions. I would also be grateful for any prayers for me and my brother bishops during our General Assembly, that we may follow the guidance of the Holy Spirit in responding to the tragedy of clergy sexual abuse in the Church.

Please be assured of my prayers for you as well.

November 12**


