
The second collection this weekend is for the **Campaign for Human Development**. On this day, which is also World Day of the Poor, bear in mind the sufferings of those in poverty, and to support CCHD, which helps provide the skills and opportunities needed in order to live independently and with dignity. In our diocese, CCHD grant funding supports work with low-income families and those with mental illness, and helps homeless people gain skills that will support them. Theological Questions

Last week's question: In musical terminology, what are sharps and flats?

A note that is "sharp" is slightly higher in pitch than the "natural" note. More specifically, it is higher in pitch by one semitone (a half step). Sharp is the opposite of "flat", which is a lowering of pitch by a half step.

The **black keys** on a piano are a half step higher or lower than the neighboring white keys, and they represent the sharps and flats in a musical scale. In musical notation, a sharp or a flat is written on the same line or space as the natural note, but it is preceded by the sharp sign (#) or the flat sign (b). A return to the natural note is indicated by the natural sign (♮).



In ancient Gregorian chant notation, there were only seven notes in a "diatonic" scale (Do, Re, Mi, Fa, Sol, La, Ti), with no use of sharps or flats. In modern musical notation, there are twelve half tones in a "chromatic" scale, with a greater use of sharps and flats.

New Question: In music, what is an octave?
