



Travel bursary terms and conditions

About

We are thrilled to be able to offer travel bursaries for partners attending our in-person Blockly Summit on 3 - 4 June 2026. Bursaries will be awarded by the Raspberry Pi Foundation. The aim of providing financial support is to help offset the costs associated with attending our events.

Bursaries are intended as a contribution to travel expenses such as flights, fuel, taxis, and reasonable costs that are expected to be incurred as a result of attending this event.

All bursary awards are granted at the sole discretion of the Raspberry Pi Foundation. Meeting the initial eligibility criteria does not guarantee an award or a specific level of funding.

In order to be eligible for consideration:

- You must be attending the Blockly Summit between 3-4 June 2026
- You must be over 18
- You must have applied before the deadline.

Awards are calculated on a case-by-case basis based on the contextual information provided within the bursary application form, including but not limited to financial need and supporting documentation. The selection process takes into account many factors including need, geography, community involvement and ensuring a diverse group of participants.

The Raspberry Pi Foundation is not responsible for any individual attending the event. We reserve the right to terminate the agreed travel funds at any time, where the recipient holder no longer meets the terms and conditions stated here.

- Failure to attend the event will result in the bursary amount being payable back to the Raspberry Pi Foundation.
- Bursary applicants must complete the form, including their bank details, at least 10 working days in advance of the event.
