A&M has advanced to the NCAA Championship each of the last six years, the longest string in school history.

TEXAS A&M/UIC SERIES NOTABLES

The Aggies and Flames have met on the diamond on four prior occasions with Texas A&M leading 4-0 ... The first meeting came on May 30, 2008, during the NCAA College Station Regional at Olsen Field ... Texas A&M emerged the winner on that day by a score of 15-1, led by first baseman Luke Anders, who went 4-for-4 with a home run and five runs scored, and designated hitter Darby Brown, who also homered and drove in five runs during the win ... Last season, the Aggies swept a three-game series as Tyler Naquin batted .545 with eight runs, Matt Juengst hit .500 with five runs and five RBI and Jacob House hit two home runs.

MORE ON UIC

The Flames are coming off a 23-34 campaign in 2012 that saw them come up one game shy of an NCAA Championship berth. UIC advanced to the championship game of the Horizon League Tournament, but lost a 14-5 decision to the Valparaiso Crusaders... The Flames finished 12-17 in Horizon League action, fourth place in the league standings... UIC has won a share of the Horizon League regular-season title 10 of the last 13 seasons and the Flames have made NCAA Championship appearances since 2003... UIC won one game in NCAA Regional play in both 2007 (#16 Long Beach State, 4-1, at Long Beach Regional) and 2008 (Dallas Baptist, 9-5, at College Station Regional)... UIC returns 22 letterwinners from last season's squad ... The team is led by head coach Mike Dee, who is in his 15th year at the helm of the program and has a career record of 443-336-1 (.569)... The Flames most prolific alum is three-time MLB All-Star outfielder Curtis Granderson.

NOTES AND NOTABLES

- Head coach Rob Childress enters his eighth season at the helm of the Texas A&M baseball program, beginning the year with a 289-153-2 record. Last season, he lead the Aggies to the postseason for a school-record sixth-consecutive season.
- Texas A&M welcomes back 17 letterwinners, including five positional starters, from last season's 43-18 team that advanced to the NCAA Championship. The Aggies return two All-Big 12 Second Team performers in Troy Stein (C) and Mikey Reynolds. They are joined by Blake Allemand (INF) and Kyle Martin (RHP) who garnered All-Big 12 Honorable Mention a year ago. Allemand and Chance Bolcerek were Big 12 All-Freshman selections.
- The Aggies enter the season ranked in the Top 25 in two of the four major college baseball polls, earning the No. 24 ranking in both the USA Today/ESPN Coaches Poll and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association.

FRIDAY'S PROBABLE STARTER: #32 KYLE MARTIN

After 77 relief appearances in his first three seasons in College Station, senior Kyle Martin makes his first collegiate start on Friday night ... The 77 appearances ranks seventh on A&M's career list ... Last season Martin served as the Aggies' closer, going 6-5 with seven saves and a 3.20 ERA ... He was All-Big 12 Honorable Mention as a junior.

AGGIES SELECTED FIFTH IN THE SEC WESTERN DIVISION

The Texas A&M baseball team will need to earn love in the SEC as the league’s coaches relegated the Aggies to fifth in the SEC Western Division in the league’s preseason coaches poll released on Tuesday.

Arkansas was selected as the favorite in the Western Division, earning 12 of the 14 first-place votes. LSU and Mississippi State were slotted in second and third place with one first-place vote apiece. Ole Miss was tabbed fourth followed by Texas A&M, Alabama and Auburn.

Vanderbilt was ranked first in the Eastern Division with 12 first-place votes, followed by Florida in second place. Kentucky and South Carolina were tied for third and each garnered one first-place vote. Georgia was picked fifth, followed by Tennessee and fellow league newcomer Missouri.

GRUELING SCHEDULE

The Aggies schedule features eight teams in the *Baseball America* Preseason Top 25 for a total of 20 games. The slate also highlights seven games against three teams in the *BA* Preseason Top 5 and 13 games against five teams in the *BA* Preseason Top 10. The Aggies play preseason No. 1 North Carolina and No. 18 Rice at the Astros Foundation College Classic at Minute Maid Park. They have a non-conference road series at No. 22 Cal State Fullerton. They have SEC series at No. 13 Ole Miss, No. 7 South Carolina and No. 3 Arkansas and SEC home series against No. 5 Mississippi State and No. 10 LSU.

MORE ON THE 2013 SCHEDULE

Fourteen teams on Texas A&M’s 2013 schedule will be coming off NCAA tournament campaigns. Of the 14 squads who earned a berth in the field of 64 in ‘13, four hosted regionals and Arkansas and South Carolina both advanced to the College World Series in Omaha where the Gamecocks finished as national runner-up to Arizona. Eight of the Aggies’ opponents racked up 40 or more wins. The Aggies will play a total of 31 games against 2012 NCAA tourney teams this spring.

A&M HOME OPENERS

Fans always look forward to opening day, and the trend in recent years is for strong crowds to show up for the first pitch of the season.

The all-time record opening day crowd at Olsen Field at Blue Bell Park was on February 25, 2005, when the Aggies defeated 19th-ranked Washington, 10-4, before an overflow crowd of 7,669. The crowd was not only the largest on an opening day at Texas A&M but the largest non-conference crowd in the stadium’s history.

A&M returns a solid core and many of its key contributors from 2012, which saw the squad connect on 30 home runs, score an average of 5.8 runs per game and swipe 110 bases while adjusting to significant changes in the bats used in college baseball.

Top returnees on the offensive side include All-Big 12 Second Team performers Mikey Reynolds at short-stop and Troy Stein at catcher. Reynolds hit .306 with 55 runs, 12 doubles, three triples, one home run, 23 RBI and 21 stolen bases. Stein hit .304 with 16 runs, 12 doubles, two home runs and 25 RBI.

Brandon Wood has the most power among the Aggies' returnees. He hit .258 with 30 runs, 10 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 25 RBI and 10 stolen bases in 2012.

Krey Bratsen batted .332 as a rookie while collecting eight extra base hits, scoring 45 runs and driving in 36 himself. Additionally, the speedster swiped 31 bases, the seventh highest single season total in school history. Last season he batted .226 with 34 runs, five doubles, two triples, 25 RBI and 21 stolen bases.

Blake Allemand made the Big 12 All-Freshman team as an infielder. He hit appeared in 50 games with 29 starts at third base and 12 starts at second base. He batted .289 with 16 runs, three doubles, two triples, 14 RBI and four stolen bases in 2012.

HEAD COACH ROB CHILDRESS

One of the top pitching coaches and recruiters in the country, Rob Childress enters his eighth season as the head coach of the Texas A&M baseball program.

The Gilmer, Texas, native's expertise as a pitching coach is evident and has made an immediate impact as A&M's pitching staff has ranked first or second in the rugged Big 12 in earned run average in each of his seven seasons, including a Big 12-best 2.92 team ERA in 2012.



During the 2012 campaign, Childress guided the Aggies to a school-record sixth consecutive trip to the NCAA tournament as A&M hosted an NCAA Regional in College Station for the second straight season.

In 2011, Childress captured co-Big 12 Coach of the Year honors as he led the Aggies to another milestone campaign as he guided the squad back to college baseball's promised land of Omaha, Neb., and the College World Series. The trip to Omaha was the fifth in program history and capped off another successful run in the NCAA Tournament as the Aggies reached the postseason for a school-record fifth consecutive time in six seasons during Childress' tenure.

The 2011 team also claimed the 23rd conference championship in program history as it brought home both the Big 12 regular season and tournament titles before emerging victorious in both the College Station Regional and Tallahassee Super Regional.

During the 2011 season, Childress and the Aggies also accomplished something never done before in the program's 109-year history by earning a fifth consecutive trip to the NCAA Tournament. The 2011 campaign also saw Texas A&M claim 47 victories to surpass the 40-win plateau for the fourth time in five seasons.

Under Childress' guidance in 2010, the Aggies once again ascended to the top of the Big 12 as they claimed yet another conference crown under Childress' direction when A&M won the league's postseason tournament. In 2009, Childress guided the Aggies to 37 wins and another trip to the postseason.

Named the Big 12's Coach of the Year by his peers in 2008, Childress guided the Aggies to 46 wins, their first regular-season championship in nine years and the first back-to-back NCAA regional championships in school history. Along the way A&M set a new school and Big 12 record by winning 16 straight conference games.

After just one season at the helm, Childress orchestrated the biggest turnaround in NCAA Division I baseball. His 2007 team finished 48-19, winning 23 more games than in 2006, in addition to claiming the NCAA College Station Regional championship, a berth in the Super Regionals and the school's first Big 12 title since 1999.

Childress was named the 19th head baseball coach in school history on June 21, 2005.

POSTSEASON STREAK CONTINUES INTO 2013

Prior to the arrival of head coach Rob Childress, Texas A&M had never appeared in the NCAA Tournament more than four consecutive years. Hosting an NCAA Regional in 2012 extended the Aggies current string to six consecutive years, something that had never happened before in the program's 112 year history.

Childress has led the Aggies to the postseason each of the last six seasons, topping the previous-high water mark of four-straight trips, a feat that had happened only twice before at Texas A&M. Former head coach Tom Chandler led his squad to the NCAA Regionals each season from 1975 to 1978 and 11 years later the Aggies enjoyed a similar four-year run from 1986-89 under the direction of head coach Mark Johnson.

MARTIN NOW APPEARING

Now the Aggies' Friday night starter, Kyle Martin spent his first three seasons as a stalwart in the bullpen. He currently ranks seventh on A&M's career list with 77 appearances. It will be a harder record to reach as a starter, but he's chasing Kyle Thebeau's record of 103 appearances between 2006-09.

AGGIES ON THE TUBE

No stranger to the national spotlight, the Aggies have had 55 of their games televised either regionally or nationally over the last six years. Texas A&M is scheduled to make eight regular-season TV appearances during the 2013 regular season as part of the SEC TV package.

The entire SEC broadcast package will include over 70 contests. In addition, all games from the 2013 SEC Tournament will continue to be televised, with the championship game airing again nationally on ESPN2. The semifinals will also air nationally for the first time, which will be broadcast on ESPNEWS.

The Aggies had previously been announced for two games as part of the Thursday Night Baseball package for ESPN, including a road game on March 28 at South Carolina and a home game on May 9 against LSU.

Texas A&M will have four home games as part of the package. All three games against LSU will be on TV. In addition to the Thursday night game, the Aggies will play the Tigers on CSS on May 10 and ESPN on May 11. A&M will host Mississippi State on Fox Sports Net on April 13.

In addition to the road game at South Carolina, Aggies will be featured at Ole Miss on ESPNU (March 23) and at Arkansas on ESPNU (April 20) and ESPN2 (April 21).

Texas A&M is in the midst of its first season in the Southeastern Conference. After 16 seasons in the Big 12 Conference, the Aggies will meet a new set of league mates. This year, A&M will face 10 of 13 possible conference opponents in the regular season, with no series scheduled against Florida, Kentucky and Vanderbilt this season.

The Aggies are 122-84-3 (.591) against current members of the SEC, including 3-0 vs. Alabama, 38-29-1 vs. Arkansas, 6-1 vs. Florida, 3-1 vs. Kentucky, 15-12-1 vs. LSU, 4-2 vs. Ole Miss, 8-6 vs. Mississippi State, 44-32-1 vs. Missouri, 0-1 vs. South Carolina, 1-0 vs. Tennessee. With long-time Big 12 companion Missouri out of the equation, A&M enters 2012 campaign with a 78-52-2 (.595) mark against the old guard. Texas A&M has never faced Auburn, Georgia and Vanderbilt.

2013 SEC TOURNAMENT

The 2013 SEC Baseball Tournament is scheduled for May 21-26 at Hoover Metropolitan Stadium in Hoover, Ala., a suburb of Birmingham.

The tournament, being held in Hoover for the 16th consecutive year, will increase from 10 to 12 teams and will begin on Tuesday, May 21. Seeds 5-12 will meet in a single elimination format on the opening day of the tournament, followed by traditional double-elimination play Wednesday-Friday. The tournament will return to single elimination play on Saturday.

The 12 teams are seeded 1-12 with two divisional champions and top four seeds guaranteed opening-round byes, with the possibility of earning another by later in the bracket. The tournament field will include the top teams from the SEC's Eastern and Western Divisions plus 10 at-large bids seeded 3-12 based on conference winning percentage.

UP NEXT

Texas A&M will host games on Tuesday and Wednesday against Stephen F. Austin and Texas Southern, respectively... Last season, the Aggies defeated SFA, 4-3, and did not play against Texas Southern.
