Buyers call delivery

Producer must complete and sign a Grower Agreement and IP Checklist

It is a BUSHEL contract

NPE contracts will be put in for their bushels. Overrun is by agreement only.**

This is not variety specific

Seed receipts must be produced if requested

Specifications:

Max .2% yellow corn allowed in a sample. Amounts over .2% could be subject to rejection.

Other Details:

Delivery is set in a 30 day time of shipment. This is BUYERS CALL. The goal is for delivery to occur within the contracted window but occasional delays could cause it to fall into the first 2 weeks of the next month. Once we fill a shipment it is FULL. As we do get closer to delivery, we may be able to make some adjustments.***LAFAYETTE WILL BE 60 DAY BUYERS CALL. There will be a nongmo delivery every 4-6 weeks and it will require wider shipment

Price is location delivered basis + the premium + futures = Cash Price. Any Cargill contract alternatives can be used with the contract. NPE (DP) with fees will be available on a limited quantity of bushels at the elevators. Storage is not an option on nongmo grains. **DP WILL NOT BE OFFERED ON LAFAYETTE NONGMO

When signing up, keep in mind that the max bushels that could be delivered in a 3-5 day time frame in a given month. This is a guideline to keep a customers from over committing themselves to delivery and to allow multiple customers to spread out logistics risk. **LAFAYETTE WILL BE 3 DAY DELIVERY WINDOW IN MOST CASES

During the fall we will have more space and flexible delivery available at the elevators. As harvest progresses, and as we fill our space, we will have to work around train timing etc.

Buyers Call means that we will contact the producer to arrange delivery timing for the beans. 30 days at elevators, 60 days at Lafayette.

Grain is tested for nongmo purity upon arrival to destination.
