



Pick your “Q” herbicide

Pick your “Q” herbicide to build a weed control program that works for you: field by field or across the farm.

Start with a strong base

For your first pass, apply one of the following herbicide brands:

- FulTime® NXT
- Keystone® LA NXT
- Keystone® NXT
- Resicore®*
- Surpass® NXT
- SureStart® II

**Do not apply more than 3.85 ounces active ingredient of mesotrione in a year.*

Benefits from establishing a strong base:

- Controls majority of weeds when they are most vulnerable
- Removes early stress on corn allowing better early growth
- Increases application window for a timely POST treatment

- Products that cover a broad spectrum of grass and broadleaf weeds
- Flexible application, can be used on field corn through V6
- “Q” is a built in safener

Accent® Q

HERBICIDE

- Late POST applications
- Grass control with corn type flexibility
- For early applications, include a residual (group 15)
- Best tank-mix option with Resicore in postemergence applications

Realm® Q

HERBICIDE

- Row and Go application
- Grass and Broadleaf (HPPD) burndown + residual
- Early-Mid POST applications

Revulin® Q

HERBICIDE

- Convenient premix of grass control + HPPD broadleaf control
- Corn type flexibility Field, seed, pop, sweet
- Best when tank-mixed with a residual (group 15)
- Mid POST applications

Steadfast® Q

HERBICIDE

- Tough/larger grasses
- Grass burndown + residual
- Use tank-mix for broadleaf control
- Mid POST applications

Recommended Adjuvants: Always add AMS. COC or MSO is preferred over NIS, depending on tank-mix partners selected.
